We sat down with the Indiana-born singer, songwriter, Army veteran, and father of four to talk about music, resilience, and his relentless fight to be heard in today's industry.

Born to Sing, Built to Survive The Unbreakable Spirit of Gary Chamberlain

When you listen to Gary Chamberlain sing, you're not just hearing a voice, you're hearing a lifetime of stories, grit, heartbreak, and redemption. You're hearing a man who has lived boldly, served honorably, and risen above tragedies that would silence most. You're also hearing "Little Gary," the son he tragically lost and continues to honor through every note he sings.

Early Beginnings

Gary's musical journey began before most kids even had a curfew. "At 14, I put on a concert for the student staff and faculty at Hamilton Southeastern Junior High School," he recalls with a smile. "I was writing my own original music, performing as a lead vocalist, and playing at local events. That's when I started gaining attention."

By that time, Gary was also heavily involved in athletics, including football, basketball, cross-country, and wrestling, but music kept calling him back. And it wasn't long before Indiana took notice.

Gary was selected by sportscaster Dave Calabro for Dave's Team, a popular news segment on WTHR Channel 13. Soon after, Fox 59 featured him performing the National Anthem at a high school football game, and even spotlighted how his original songs were played over the PA system during school passing periods.

"That was surreal, hearing my own music echoing through the hallways, that's when I knew this was bigger than a hobby," Gary says.

'Teen Country Magazine' soon featured him, and that's when things really exploded. Gary began touring and opening for national recording artists while still a teenager.

Sharing the Stage with Legends

The list of musicians Chamberlain has performed with reads like a Country Music Hall of Fame roster: Garth Brooks, Vince Gill, Martina McBride, The Charlie Daniels Band, Tracy Lawrence, Mark Chesnutt, Little Texas, Lady Antebellum, and Ronnie Milsap.

"In the mid-1990s, I opened for Garth Brooks," Gary recalls. "I was lucky enough to learn how to play *The Dance* from Garth's guitar player, Ty England."

Another memory still makes him laugh. "I remember hanging out with Steve Wariner and Keith Urban at a cabin in Kentucky. Steve was teaching Keith a guitar lick for *Where the Blacktop Ends*. Watching them work was magic."

But even with his rising star, Chamberlain stepped back from music at 18 to decide whether he wanted to continue his career independently, without his parents' support system.

Service, Sacrifice, and Heartbreak

Gary joined the Army National Guard and proudly served his country. In 2005, his unit, the Indiana National Guard's 38th Infantry Division, became one of the first National Guard units deployed to Mississippi after Hurricane Katrina.

"We were part of Task Force Cyclone, we provided humanitarian assistance, security, and road clearing," Gary explains.

But in 2006, tragedy shattered Gary's world. While drilling at Camp Atterbury, his First Sergeant pulled him aside: "his home was on fire."

Gary lost his 2-year-old son, Garrison Grant Chamberlain, the first fire-related fatality the town had seen in 50 years. The community mourned deeply, and Gary channeled his grief into his music.

For years, Gary dedicated himself to public service working as a police officer with the Marion County Sheriff's Department and later as an operations manager for a security company. Today, he is working toward launching his own security-focused business.

A Daughter's Words That Changed Everything

It wasn't a manager, producer, or agent who brought Gary back to music. It was his daughter, Layla Ruth.

"One evening I was playing my guitar after work, and she said, 'Dad, you just need to do music again'."

That was all it took. Gary returned to writing and recording with renewed passion. And it didn't take long for the industry to respond.

His 2023 hit *Like Johnny Cash* was nominated at the Josie Music Awards for 'Song of the Year' and his band was nominated 'Band of the Year.' The tribute track was inspired by his love for Cash's authenticity and honesty.

"I wondered what kind of song Johnny Cash would release if he were still alive today," he said. "That's how I wrote *Like Johnny Cash*."

The Battle of the Modern Independent Artist

Gary is candid about the challenges of today's streaming-driven world: "It's challenging to be heard in the modern music environment... but I refuse to give up."

He emphasizes that his mission is to create music that resonates with people. "I hope my songs, especially the lyrics - resonate with others. That's the entire reason I write, play, and perform music."

New Releases & Public Praise

In June of last year, Gary released *Need a Shot of You Again*, followed in July by *Just Go to Church*, a deeply personal reflection on loss, healing, and hope.

"The lyrics and music are beautiful. There's pain and honesty," says Ryan Ahlwardt, host of *Indy Now* on Fox 59.



Fans across states agree:

"Great band and great people. Love the hit single *Like Johnny Cash*," says Ryan Edwards of Lapel, Indiana.

"This dude rocks, I'd go see him anytime!!" adds Joseph DeSario of Spring Hill, Florida.

A Story for the Ages

Gary's life, marked by soaring highs and unimaginable lows, has shaped him into an artist with profound emotional depth.

"The losses and challenges I faced taught me to appreciate and master the art of writing, singing, and playing music," he says. "Never give up on your dreams."

His commitment is clear: No AI. No shortcuts. Just genuine, human music.





DAVID MIKEAL

The Architect of Modern American Sound

For more than four decades, David Mikeal has been quietly shaping the sound of American music - not from the front pages of tabloids or the glare of celebrity culture, but from the control rooms, scoring stages, and creative trenches where real artistry is forged.

Composer. Producer. Multi-instrumentalist. Engineer. Vocalist. Mikeal is the rare figure whose fingerprints can be found across Rock, Pop, Film, Television, and the ever-expanding world of sync licensing.

Today, he stands as one of the most versatile and respected creators in the industry, a veteran whose catalog bridges legacy credibility with fresh cinematic power. Signed to Galaxy Class Records - the flagship label of Galaxy Class Entertainment Inc. - Mikeal serves as lead vocalist, writer, and co-producer for the acclaimed group Creation V. It's a role that showcases not only his musicality, but his instinct for emotional precision and commercial clarity.

"I've always believed that music should move people - whether it's a three-minute single or a thirty-second cue, it has to mean something," Mikeal says. That philosophy has become the through-line of a career defined by both craftsmanship and conviction.

Mikeal's journey began on the national stage with A&M Records' band MPG, where he served as lead guitarist and vocalist. He later became a featured artist on CBS's Parc Records with the group BIGSHOT, earning early acclaim for his dynamic performance style and songwriting instincts.

Those early recordings - now reissued internationally through Melodic Rock Classics - have found new life with a generation rediscovering the golden era of melodic Rock. Releases with Lowery Records (CYCLE), Retrospect Records (DAVID, TIN HOUSE), and others expanded his catalog and cemented his reputation as a writer with both edge and accessibility.

His Billboard songwriting achievement award stands as a testament to that enduring voice. But Mikeal never allowed himself to be defined by one lane. Instead, he built a career that moves fluidly between genres, formats, and mediums - a rare versatility that has become his signature.

In the world of visual media, David Mikeal has become a trusted storyteller. His full original score for the feature film The Legend of Kate Kensington introduced audiences to his ability to translate emotion into orchestration. Since 2015, he has served as a lead composer for NBC's Outdoor Sports Network, crafting themes and cues that elevate the network's visual identity.

His work has also appeared across MTV Viacom and other major platforms, spanning everything from atmospheric underscore to bold thematic material.

"When you're scoring for picture, you're not just writing music, you're writing emotion, tension, release, and story," Mikeal explains. "The job is to make the audience feel something before they even know why."

That instinct - to serve the story first - is what makes his compositions so effective for film, documentary, commercial, and episodic television.

While many know Mikeal for his performance and composition, insiders know him equally as a master producer and engineer. As owner and head engineer of Studio Live USA, he has built a creative hub capable of handling everything from full-band tracking to orchestral recording.

His engineering résumé reads like a cross-section of modern music history: Don Henley (Gold-certified *Cass County*), Pat Travers Band, Silento, Badfinger, Third World, Claudia Leitte, and more.

His philosophy in the studio is refreshingly grounded. "I'm happy to do any and everything that anybody wants to do. I'm not offended, you know?" he told *Recording Connection*, reflecting on the modern collaborative landscape. "If you recorded something at home and want to take it up a couple notches, come to us. We'll mix it for you."

It's a posture of service - not ego - that has made him one of the most in-demand engineers in the Orlando area.

Through Galaxy Class Entertainment Inc., a curated library of Mikeal's sync-ready compositions is now available for licensing, a treasure trove for music supervisors seeking



depth, emotional clarity, and broadcast-ready production.

His catalog is uniquely positioned: rich with legacy credibility, yet fresh enough to meet the demands of modern cinematic storytelling.

Whether it's a feature film, a documentary, a commercial, or a streaming series, Mikeal's music carries the weight of experience and the immediacy of contemporary sound design. "Music is a language that works in every medium," he says. "If you understand people, you understand how to write for them."



The Hardest Working Man in Gospel Music Continues to Inspire the World

From the sun-soaked streets of Pasadena to the bright lights of Billboard charts and blockbuster film studios, Grammy-winning artist Brent Jones has spent his life turning passion into purpose. With a career defined by innovation, a tireless work ethic, and an unwavering commitment to uplifting others, Jones stands tall as one of Gospel music's most influential voices.

A Musical Spark Ignited Early

Born in Pasadena, California, and raised in Orange County, Brent grew up as an only child with a vibrant love for music. He remembers falling in love with the smooth melodies of '70s Yacht Rock and the rich grooves of R&B. But it was the electrifying sound of Gospel choir music that shifted the entire course of his life.

He recalls a pivotal moment from childhood: "Mesmerized by the choir director and the control he had over the singers and band, I told my parents that I wanted to be a choir director/musician for my life's work."

His parents encouraged his passion immediately buying him a piano that same week. Brent began classical training at age seven and later studied Jazz theory, a turning point that expanded his understanding of Gospel harmony and musical expression. By his early teens, he was already performing with adult choirs and composing original songs for the youth choir, inspired by his godfather.

Breaking Barriers With T.P. Mobb

In 1992, Brent formed the pioneering Gospel group Brent Jones & The T.P. Mobb, a dynamic, trendsetting ensemble of young performers who blended R&B, Hip-Hop, and Contemporary Gospel. At a time when the Gospel world leaned heavily toward traditional sounds, T.P. Mobb shook the landscape with fresh choreography, urban fashion, and chart-topping hits like *Goodtime*, *Don't Wait Till Midnight*, and *Rich*.

The group became a catalyst for future stars. Many music historians credit Brent's innovation as laying the groundwork for artists like Kirk Franklin and the modern era of Urban Contemporary Gospel. His contribution is no small footnote; it is a defining chapter in Gospel music history.

A Career Marked by Extraordinary Achievements

Across the decades, Brent Jones has built an extraordinary body of work creating, teaching, directing, and performing with the world's biggest artists, universities, and churches. His achievements read like a highlight reel of Gospel excellence.

And this list barely scratches the surface of a career spanning countless collaborations, tours, and creative ventures.

The Collaborator From Hollywood to Hitmakers

One of Brent's most celebrated roles is his work behind the scenes. As vocal director and arranger for Childish Gambino's Grammy-nominated album "Awaken My Love," Brent contributed to a project that went on to sell over a million copies. He also worked alongside Oscar-winning composer Ludwig Göransson and Justin Timberlake on the wildly successful *Trolls World Tour* soundtrack.

Over the years, he has collaborated with a star-studded lineup including Ariana Grande, Mary J. Blige, and George Clinton. This cross-genre versatility is a hallmark of Brent's musical genius.

Chart-Toppers, Choirs, and New Music

Brent's 2023 album "Nothing Else Matters" soared to #1 on the Billboard Gospel Chart, earning the Stellar Award for 'Choir of the Year.' His 2024 hit *Live Your Best Life!* followed with another #1 celebration infused with Washington, D.C. Go-Go flavor. Most recently, his youth choir's release "Brent Jones Presents The Fire" earned him yet another Stellar Award in 2025.

His current radio single, *Praise in the Choir Stand*, is climbing the charts and reconnecting audiences with the heart of Gospel choir music. "Praise is our best spiritual weapon to change situations 'That's how we win!'" Brent says.

Looking ahead, fans can anticipate his 2026 inspirational R&B album "Enjoy Your Life," already in production.

The Challenges Behind the Triumphs

Despite extraordinary success, Brent remains transparent about the difficult side of life on the road. "Touring means extensive periods of time away from my loved ones," he shares, acknowledging the emotional cost of performing 150+ dates each year. He also admits that trying to please everyone can be exhausting. "Don't follow trends... find your own musical lane and be comfortable in it." Brent reflects.

A Mission Beyond Music

Beyond the stage and studio, Brent is deeply concerned with the spiritual and cultural climate of the modern church. He observes that clout-chasing and attention-seeking have overshadowed true purpose. "Attention and clout have become the new drugs," he says, emphasizing that effectiveness, not fame, must remain the goal.

His long-term dream is to establish a nonprofit dedicated to teaching songwriting and performance to youth and emerging artists.

An Experience Fans Never Forget

A Brent Jones concert is far more than music's a full experience. Audiences can expect to dance, laugh, sing, cry, and most importantly, leave transformed. His mission is simple yet powerful: to encourage everyone to "Live Your Best Life!"

With passion, purpose, and a legacy of groundbreaking artistry, Brent Jones continues to be one of Gospel's most inspiring and innovative voices.

We pause to remember these individuals whose music and legacies will live on in the hearts of music fans for generations.

Raul Malo

August 7, 1965 - December 8, 2025

There are voices that entertain, voices that impress, and then there are voices that alter the landscape. Raul Malo belonged to that rare third category. For more than three decades, his majestic baritone - equal parts operatic power, Cuban soul, and country grit - reshaped American music and expanded the borders of what a band could be.

To speak of Malo is to speak of color, movement, and emotion. His sound was never confined to a single lane. It was a tapestry woven from the rhythms of his Miami upbringing, the heritage of his Cuban parents, and the restless creativity that defined his life. When he co-founded The Mavericks in 1989, he didn't just start a band, he launched a musical revolution.

With Malo at the helm, The Mavericks became one of the most genre-defying groups of their era. They blended Country with Rock and Roll, Jazz, Tejano, Bolero, and Big-Band swagger. They delivered hits that became instant classics - songs like *What a Crying Shame* and *All You Ever Do Is Bring Me Down* - and they did it with a sound that was unmistakably

their own. Awards followed: a Grammy, multiple CMA 'Group of the Year' honors, and a fiercely loyal fanbase that stretched across continents.

But accolades only tell part of the story. Malo's true legacy lies in the way he connected people. He was often described as a "cultural bridge," a title he wore with quiet pride. Whether singing in English or Spanish, fronting The Mavericks or exploring his solo work, he carried the heart of two worlds and made them one. His 2020 all-Spanish album, "En Español," wasn't a departure, it was a homecoming, a celebration of roots that resonated far beyond the Latin community.

Even as life brought its hardest challenges, Malo remained a storyteller. When he was diagnosed with Stage 4 colon cancer in 2024, he chose transparency over silence. He continued to perform, to write, to speak to his audience with honesty and grace. Fans watched not just a musician, but a man of courage - still giving, still creating, still reaching for connection.

Those closest to him describe him as a force of nature. A spark in every room. A laugh that filled the air. A talent that refused to be boxed in. His bandmates often said that Raul didn't just sing a song - he inhabited it. He made music feel alive.

And that is the legacy he leaves behind: a body of work that transcends genre, a career that defied expectation, and a voice that will echo for generations.

On December 8, 2025, Raul Francisco Martínez-Malo Jr. - known to the world simply as Raul Malo - passed away at his home in Nashville at the age of 60, following a courageous and very public battle with cancer. His departure came just days after a two-night tribute concert at the Ryman Auditorium, a final outpouring of love for a man whose music had shaped so many lives.

He was, and remains, one of the great American originals.





Walt Aldridge

November 12, 1955 – November 19, 2025

Some people leave a mark on the world through a single gift. Walt Aldridge left his through many. Musician. Songwriter. Producer. Engineer. Teacher. Mentor. Friend. Yet even those titles feel too small for a man whose life shaped the sound of Muscle Shoals and touched hearts far beyond Alabama's borders.

To understand Walt is to understand devotion - to his craft, to his family, and to the faith that carried him through every season. Born on November 12, 1955, in Florence, Alabama, he grew up surrounded by the warmth of Southern family life and the musical heartbeat of the Shoals. Those early years planted seeds that would grow into one of the most respected careers in American songwriting.

Walt's journey began at the legendary FAME Studios, where he worked alongside Rick Hall and an extraordinary circle of musicians who helped define an era. It was there that Walt's gifts blossomed, not only as a performer, but as a writer with a rare ability to capture emotion with clarity and truth.

His songs were recorded by major artists across genres, earning him industry acclaim and ultimately induction into both the Nashville Songwriters Hall of Fame and the Alabama Music Hall of Fame.

But Walt never chased spotlight or applause. His work was driven by something deeper - a desire to serve the song, honor the craft, and tell stories that mattered. Those who knew him often said that Walt didn't just write music; he felt it, lived it, and poured his whole heart into it.

Beyond the studio, Walt was a man of many passions. He loved hunting, fishing, traveling, and woodworking. But nothing brought him more joy than tending his garden. Every spring and summer, he grew vegetables and flowers with the same care he gave to his music. He often said the garden made him feel close to his father - a quiet, sacred connection that grounded him.

And yet, for all his accomplishments, Walt's greatest pride was his family. He was a loving son, a devoted husband, a kind father, a faithful friend. Time with them was his truest joy, the place where his heart found rest.

For nearly a decade, Walt poured his wisdom into the next generation as a professor in the Entertainment Industry Department at the University of North Alabama. Students remember him not just as a teacher, but as a mentor who believed in them, challenged them, and helped them find their own creative voice. His influence lives on in every life he shaped.

Walt's journey through illness in his final years revealed the depth of his faith. He faced every challenge with courage, anchored by the assurance that his healing - full and complete - awaited him in the presence of Jesus. That confidence gave him peace, and it gave his family strength.

On November 19, 2025, after a long and courageous battle, James Walton Aldridge, Jr. entered the arms of his Savior at the age of 70. His passing marked the close of a remarkable earthly chapter, but his legacy, like the songs he wrote, continues to echo.

He leaves behind a life rich in love, rooted in faith, and overflowing with the music that will outlive us all.

CARL WAYNE MEEKINS

Let's Get It!

Carl Wayne Meekins is the kind of artist who doesn't just take the stage - he transforms it. With a voice shaped by Rock, Country, and Gospel, and a heart shaped by faith, gratitude, and second chances, he has built a life that sings far beyond the microphone.

Some artists spend their lives chasing applause. Others spend their lives chasing purpose. Carl Wayne Meekins somehow manages to chase both - not out of ego, but out of gratitude. His motto, shouted with the enthusiasm of a man who refuses to waste a single breath, is simple: "LET'S GET IT!" It's not a slogan. It's not a brand. It's a worldview. It means: *Let's make something good happen today. Let's lift somebody up. Let's do something that matters.*

And if you follow the trail of his life - from a childhood attic in Chesapeake, Virginia, to the honky-tonks and churches of Nashville, to rodeo arenas and veterans' halls across America - you'll see that he has lived that motto with

remarkable consistency. Music is his craft, but generosity is his calling. Faith is his anchor. And gratitude is the engine that drives everything he touches.

Every great story has a moment when everything changes. For Carl Wayne, that moment happened in an attic - dusty, dim, and filled with forgotten relics of a life he didn't yet know belonged to him.

He and his twin brother, Cliff, were just kids, full of curiosity and mischief, when they climbed the ladder and discovered a treasure chest of drums, guitars, and old equipment. They had no idea their father had once been a musician. They only knew that something inside them lit up.



"We found drums and other instruments, and it blew our minds," he remembers. "Dad brought the drums down and played them, and everything made sense. That was the moment my brother and I started chasing the music within us."

From that day forward, the Meekins townhouse became a makeshift concert hall. The stereo was always loud. The bass always thumped. The neighbors always complained. And the boys always kept playing. They weren't trying to be musicians - they were simply trying to feel something. And music made them feel alive.

Even now, decades later, Carl Wayne laughs at how little has changed. "Even now, when my wife and daughter are out of the house, I still crank the music up and the eight-year-old kid comes out in me!"

His musical education came not from textbooks or formal lessons, but from vinyl records, 8-tracks, and the emotional imprint of moments that never left him. Riding in the car with his dad meant Queen, Tom Jones, and whatever 8-track happened to be in rotation. Visiting his grandmother meant Elvis' Gospel records spinning on the turntable. And then came the moment that sealed his fate: watching "Aloha from Hawaii" after Elvis' passing. "He hit that stage with his eagle cape and that massive production... I was glued like a moth to a flame."

From there, the soundtrack of his life expanded - Glen Campbell, Ronnie Milsap, Motown, and eventually Barry Manilow, whose song *I Write the Songs* became the first record ever given to him. He played in garage bands, high school bands, and anywhere else that would let him plug in an electric guitar.

But it wasn't until a friend handed him a cassette tape - Alan Jackson's "Chattahoochee" - that he realized what kind of writer he wanted to be. "That's when I realized what hooks were. I fell in love with 90s Country... especially the steel guitar. I got on the 90s Country bandwagon and I haven't left since."

Music shaped his talent, but faith shaped his character. Carl Wayne is open about the fact that his walk with Christ has had seasons of strength and seasons of struggle. But moving to Nashville became a turning point. "I learned about grace," he says. "There is nothing I can do to earn God's grace. God gives the free gift of grace - so use it."

Then came 2020, the year that nearly ended everything. He contracted Covid, was hospitalized twice, and watched a close friend die from the same illness. The fear was real. The uncertainty was suffocating. And the spiritual reckoning was unavoidable.

"I thought, I'm not going to make it," he says quietly. "I remembered the scripture that says life is but a vapor. I told Tonya, 'We came to this town to make records. I feel like I have a second chance at life. God was saying, I'm gonna give you another chance, and we're gonna do it My way.'"

That brush with death didn't just change his perspective. It changed his purpose.

Carl Wayne grew up receiving generosity - instruments, opportunities, encouragement. So when God restored his health, he knew exactly what he wanted to do with that second chance. "I love entertaining and stirring emotions in people," he says. "I decided if I can ever afford it, I want to give people the opportunity to do something with their life, just like I was given."

So he began buying guitars at wholesale and giving them away. At first, it was a handful. Then a few dozen. Today, the number is approaching one hundred.

And something unexpected happened: Veterans kept winning them. "What are you showing me here, God?" he wondered. "Imagine what a guitar can do as a therapy tool for PTSD... or for Alzheimer's and dementia."



That realization became the heartbeat of his Play It Forward campaign. He began partnering with veteran organizations, hosting luncheons, giving guitars away, performing concerts, and ending each trip by singing in a local church as a personal thank-you to the Lord. "It's been wonderful," he says. "A highlight of my trips is singing on Sunday mornings."

A Carl Wayne Meekins concert is more than a show. It's an experience - part revival, part celebration, part family gathering. He tells stories. He laughs. He cries. He gets the crowd involved. He gives away a guitar. And he pours every ounce of himself into the moment. "We play originals and 90s Country covers," he says. "It's warmth to the soul."

His song *Pebble* has become the unofficial anthem of his mission, a reminder that small acts of kindness create ripples that change lives.

"I hope someone hears the song and it resonates," he says. "Maybe they'll go help someone. God gives us all talents and gifts. Pay it forward. Give unconditionally with no strings attached."

Carl Wayne doesn't measure success the way the world does. He measures it in lives touched, guitars given, prayers answered, and moments where God's presence feels unmistakable. He dreams of playing the Grand Ole Opry. He hopes to tour out west. He plans to release more music. But he holds all of it loosely.



"I'm gonna rely on God's timing," he says. "If you took everything away and asked if it was worth it - 100%. I can go anywhere and know I am in the will of God."

And that is the essence of Carl Wayne Meekins: a man who survived, a man who believes, a man who gives, and a man who lives every day with the same fire that first sparked in an attic full of forgotten instruments.

Haven Slay

*A Bluegrass Heart with
a Wide-Open Horizon*

Haven Slay is one of those rare young artists whose story feels both timeless and brand new. Rooted in a deep family tradition of Bluegrass, yet shaped by a life that's carried her from the Gulf Coast to the Rocky Mountains, she brings a soulful authenticity to every stage she steps onto. With a fiddle in her hands, a voice full of heart, and a mission to bring peace and happiness to those who listen, Haven is quickly emerging as one of the most compelling new voices in Americana and Bluegrass.

Some artists grow into music slowly, discovering their voice over time. Haven Slay was born into it. Raised in the warm Gulf Coast city of Pensacola, Florida, she grew up in a home where instruments leaned in corners like old friends and harmonies floated through the air like part of the weather.

Music wasn't an activity - it was a way of life. "I was born into a musical family," Haven says. "My dad, Scott, plays guitar and mandolin. My Pawpaw plays banjo and dobro. My grandma, Grams, plays upright bass. And my mom and Grammy both sing beautifully." With a lineage like that, it's no surprise that Haven began singing at just two years old and picked up the fiddle at three. "My dad asked if I wanted to play, and of course I said yes," she laughs. "I fell in love with music very early in life."

One of her earliest memories is standing onstage with her dad and Pawpaw, performing Alison Krauss' rendition of *When You Say Nothing at All*. She was just a little girl, but the moment lit a spark that has never gone out. By age six, she was taking formal violin lessons and soon joined the Emerald Coast Honors Orchestra, performing at community events and even Disney World.

Her childhood was a blend of Florida sunshine and cross-country adventure. Haven spent most of the year with her mom in Pensacola, but summers were spent traveling with her dad to Virginia Beach, Silver Spring, Centennial, and Denver. Those miles shaped her. "It gave me a wide lens on the world, and on the stages music could reach," she says.

At fifteen, a move to Longmont, Colorado opened a new chapter. Haven joined her school's choir and began performing more frequently with her dad's Colorado-based Bluegrass band, Slay & Stinson. From intimate venues to notable stages like Cavefest in Nashville, the band's momentum grew, and so did Haven's confidence as both a performer and a songwriter.

By sixteen, she was playing gigs regularly. "I've enjoyed playing with so many talented musicians and bands," she says. "Shoutout to Five Foot Betty, Slay & Stinson, and GirlGrass!" Five Foot Betty - all-female Sunny Americana group featuring Sharon Glassman, Pam Browning, and Liz Patton - became a creative home for her. So did GirlGrass, her heartfelt acoustic duo with singer-songwriter Sarah Minto-Sparks. Their performance at the SnowyGrass Bluegrass Festival in Estes Park, Colorado became a highlight of her summer.

But one of the biggest turning points came when Dog House Music Studios in Lafayette, Colorado awarded Haven a full scholarship to professionally record three original songs. "It was such a blessing," she says. "They believed in my story and my music." That opportunity opened the door to a collaboration with Buckshot Records and Artist Development in Boyce, Louisiana, a partnership she speaks of with genuine excitement. "I'm so thankful to be signed to Buckshot Music Records. They really rock! It's exciting to share my songs with those listening and see what happens."

Her first releases are now underway, including the highly anticipated *Alabama Sugar* (Bluegrass Mix). It's a milestone that feels both surreal and deeply earned.



Yet, for all the stages she's played, all the songs she's written, and all the doors opening before her, Haven's mission remains beautifully simple. "I just want to bring peace and happiness to those who listen," she says. It's a sentiment that reflects not only her artistry, but her heart - steady, soulful, and rooted in the traditions that raised her.

With a voice shaped by Bluegrass heritage, a spirit shaped by travel and family, and a future shaped by hard work and authenticity, Haven Slay is a rising artist whose journey is only just beginning. And if her story so far is any indication, the road ahead is wide open.





Boy began not with an idea or image, but with a feeling. "I'm not sure I can even tell you what this song is about," Maudal admits. "This one was music before it was words. The chords came first, and then there was that first line - 'Your back is a road, boy.' It just stared back at me. The rest of the song followed where it wanted to go. I didn't try to force meaning into it. I think people will have to find their own."

That intuitive, open-ended approach gives *Boy* its haunting depth. The song unfolds like a riddle, each verse a brushstroke in a portrait that never fully reveals its subject. Over Maudal's signature hand-built guitar tones - rich,

resonant, and unmistakably organic - the arrangement gains additional dimension through the contributions of an exceptional ensemble: Elizabeth Hangan delivers a stirring and intimate lead vocal, while Norrel Thompson and Maudal himself add harmony vocals that echo like spectral companions. Marc Weller's guitar, Carl Byron's Hammond B3, and Ross Schodek's bass enrich the soundscape with warmth and tension. Maudal further grounds the track's rhythmic pulse with acoustic guitar and drums, shaping the song's dreamlike motion with both delicacy and drive.

Musically, *Boy* drifts in a dreamlike space between folk minimalism and art-song atmosphere. Sparse yet immersive, the arrangement leaves room for silence to speak as powerfully as sound.

For Maudal, who's as much a philosopher as a musician, *Boy* represents a new chapter in his artistic evolution. "It's not a song I understand," he says. "But maybe we don't need to..."

With *Boy*, Baldy Crawlers invite listeners not to solve a song, but to sit inside it, to rest in its mystery, and maybe find a reflection of themselves along the road.



Jelly Roll, you are officially invited to become a member of the Grand Ole Opry. It's an honor to say, 'Welcome to the family, brother.'"

By the time the video ended, the singer was already overcome with emotion, even asking host Rogan for a hug. "I bet I'm the first person to ever get invited to the Grand Ole Opry on a podcast!" he exclaimed.

Jelly Roll made his Grand Ole Opry debut on November 9th, 2021. Before sharing Morgan's video message with his guest, Rogan played a clip from that night. In the recording, Jelly Roll discusses how Morgan's song *Almost Home* provided him with inspiration and strength when he was formerly incarcerated. When he was released, he was able to see Morgan perform the song live at the Opry, and even pointed out his seat from the stage.



His songwriting is melodic and cinematic, his guitar work both precise and soulful, and his leadership gives Creation V its sonic identity.

JIMMIE SMITH: THE GROOVE THAT HOLDS IT ALL TOGETHER

If Dave is the heartbeat, Jimmie Smith is the pulse. Originally from Alabama, Jimmie moved to Orlando in the late 1960s and quickly immersed himself in the local music scene. He began playing in clubs at an early age, absorbing influences from bass legends like Jack Bruce, Paul McCartney, and Tim Bogert.


His résumé includes performances with major-label artists such as The Pat Travers Band and Tin House, experiences that shaped his tone, feel, and stage presence. Jimmie's playing is warm, grounded, and deeply musical - the kind of bass work that doesn't just support a song, but elevates it.

JAY NEWCOMER: THE VETERAN WITH A RENEWED FIRE

If Creation V has a secret weapon, it's Jay Newcomer. Born in Washington, D.C., Jay began performing in local nightspots at just fifteen years old. In 1973, he joined The Joe Savage Band, embarking on a fourteen-year run with a high-energy, multi-media, theatrical Rock show that toured extensively.

Jay eventually settled in Orlando in 1987, where he became a fixture in the Lake Buena Vista music scene, performing in several hotels before securing a five-year





residency at Disney's Pleasure Island beginning in 1990. His keyboard work is expressive and cinematic, adding depth, color, and emotional resonance to Creation V's arrangements.

After an extended hiatus from the stage, Jay found renewed passion and purpose when he joined Creation V. When he's not performing, he and his wife Mary devote their time to giving back to the Orlando community, a reflection of the heart he brings to the band.

A BAND BUILT ON EXPERIENCE - AND READY FOR WHAT'S NEXT

Creation V is not a group of newcomers hoping to find their footing. They are veterans - musicians who have lived the highs and lows of the industry, who have toured, recorded, collaborated, and grown through decades of musical evolution. Then my whole family of musicians - and of course Diamond Rio, Alabama, Chris Stapleton, Luke Combs... just so many, to be honest."

Chad's first public performance came at just fourteen years old, when he stepped onto a small community stage and sang George Strait's classic *The Chair*. The performance won over the crowd and earned him his first paid gig at a local Cornwall bar called P.G.'s. More importantly, it ignited something inside him - a passion for performing that has never faded. "I've been playing in bars since I was fourteen," Chad recalls. "I performed every weekend. I never had a Friday or Saturday off in thirty-three years."

In January 2023, Chad took a major step forward by beginning to write his own music. His songwriting draws heavily from his upbringing in Cornwall - the joys, the heartaches, the simplicity of small-town life. His honest lyrics and authentic sound quickly resonated with listeners, helping him build a loyal and growing fan base.

Later that same year, Chad experienced a breakthrough moment. His first self-written song, a heartfelt tribute to his late mother Bonnie, soared to number one on Music Mafia Radio. The emotional ballad not only introduced him to a wider audience but also earned him a nomination for 'Male Artist of the Year' 2023 on Music Mafia Radio, a milestone that affirmed he was on the right path.

Chad's music blends traditional Country roots with modern storytelling, marked by emotional depth, intricate guitar work, and a soulful, unmistakable voice. His sound honors the genre's heritage while bringing a fresh, contemporary edge that appeals to today's listeners.

His career has continued to rise. In 2024, Chad won the ISSA 'International Entertainer of the Year' GOLD Award in Atlanta, Georgia, a moment he describes as unforgettable. "Having my eighth #1 on radio... and then multiple award nominations in 2025, it's a childhood dream come true!"

His latest single, *Pour Decisions*, is already gaining traction, and he has eight more songs scheduled for release later this year.



Chad also carries with him a deeply personal spiritual experience that continues to shape his life and music. "I saw my mother in my kitchen drinking coffee at 3:00 AM," he shares. "It was two weeks after she passed away. When I realized what I was seeing, I turned back, and she was gone. But the chair was pushed out, and an empty coffee mug was on the table where she had been sitting. It showed me the afterlife exists, and it gave me hope that I'll see her again. I miss her so much."

For Chad Rivette, music is more than a career, it's a calling. "My goal is to never stop chasing my dream of hitting the big stage and sharing my music globally," he says. "Music is my life. It's what I'm meant to do. I feel it inside me."

As Chad continues to write, record, and perform, his presence in the Country music world grows stronger. With his down-to-earth personality, relatable lyrics, and undeniable talent, he isn't just a singer, he's a storyteller. And his journey stands as a testament to hard work, passion, and staying true to one's roots.

Where Are They Now?

A Retrospective Glimpse at Yesterday's Rising Music Stars
Who Became Icons and Where They Are Today

THIS EDITION: Deniece Williams

Described as “one of the great soul voices” by the BBC, Deniece Williams first achieved success as an award-winning singer, songwriter, and producer in the 1970s and ‘80s. She is best known for the songs *Free, Silly, It's Gonna Take a Miracle*, and two Billboard Hot 100 No.1 singles *Let's Hear It for the Boy* and *Too Much, Too Little, Too Late* (with Johnny Mathis).

Deniece Williams was born in Gary, Indiana and grew up singing in the Church of God in Christ. Her favorite vocalists were Carmen McRae and Nancy Wilson, and she was also inspired by her parents, both of whom sang. From 1968 through 1970, while in her late teens, Williams recorded six singles for the Chicago-based Toddlin' Town label. None of the singles charted, but *I'm Walking Away* and *Mama, I Wish I Stayed at Home* became favorites of the U.K.’s northern soul scene. Williams temporarily left music behind to pursue nursing education and steady employment and started a family.

Through her cousin, Williams met Stevie Wonder - another one of her favorites - backstage at a concert. This led to an audition and her joining Wonderlove, Wonder’s group of background vocalists. Williams performed and recorded

with the Motown artist for a three-year period that included the sessions for “Talking Book,” “Fulfillingness’ First Finale,” and “Songs in the Key of Life.” During this time, Williams contributed background vocals to recordings by numerous other artists ranging from Don Everly and Kenny Rankin to Esther Phillips and Roberta Flack. She also co-wrote material for the Soul Train Gang (including the Wonder-arranged, *Baby Open the Door*, featuring her on co-lead vocals) and Merry Clayton (*How'd I Know*).

Williams pursued a solo career and signed a production deal with Maurice White and Charles Stepney and joined the roster of Columbia Records, home to White’s band, Earth, Wind & Fire. Williams released her first album, “This Is Niecy,” in 1976. Produced by Stepney and White, it featured the number 2 hit *Free*, which also crossed over to number 25 on the Hot 100. *Cause You Love Me Baby* and *That's What Friends Are For* also charted. Williams co-wrote all three of the singles, and among the deep cuts was *Slip Away*.

Williams’ second album, recorded in the wake of Stepney’s death by heart attack, yielded the Top 20 soul single *Baby, Baby My Love's All for You*. After that, she connected with fellow Columbia artist Johnny Mathis for *Too Much, Too Little, Too Late*, which was a number one hit on the Soul, and Adult Contemporary charts. Its success led to the duet partners making the album, “That's What Friends Are For.”



Williams changed direction somewhat with her third solo album, her first to bear the imprint of Maurice White's Columbia-distributed ARC (short for American Recording Company). Released in 1979, "When Love Comes Calling" saw Williams work separately with David Foster and Ray Parker, Jr. as co-producers. The biggest single from the album was *I've Got the Last Dance*.

Williams had two more LPs to cut for ARC. "My Melody" and "Niecy," respectively released in 1981 and 1982, were well-received collaborations with Philly Soul originator Thom Bell. That resulted in the singer's third gold album (for the former), Top 20 soul entries with *What Two Can Do and Silly*, and a number one soul hit with *It's Gonna Take a Miracle*, her first Grammy-nominated recording (for 'Best R&B Vocal Performance, Female'). In '82, Williams and Mathis were heard together again on the theme for the television sitcom *Family Ties*, *Without Us*.

Williams moved back to Columbia records for her next two albums teaming up with George Duke. In 1983 she released "I'm So Proud," highlighted by the number nine Black Singles hit *Do What You Feel*, earned Williams' second Grammy nomination for 'Best R&B Performance' and was followed by another hit duet with Mathis, an update of *Love Won't Let Me Wait*.

Deneice was approached by Paramount to record the bubbly *Let's Hear It for the Boy* for the soundtrack of "Footloose." The song scored a global hit that in the U.S. alone topped the Hot 100, Black Singles, and Dance charts. *Next Love* also charted from the album "Let's Hear It for the Boy," which was among the nominees for 'Best R&B Performance' in the female category. *Let's Hear It for the Boy* itself was nominated for a Grammy in the pop performance field.

Rather than take advantage of her considerable Pop momentum, Williams opted to record her first Contemporary Gospel album. The decision wasn't all that surprising given that her LPs dating back to "This Is Niecy" contained faith-based material. *Whiter Than Snow* was nominated for a Grammy as 'Best Inspirational Song.' "So Glad I Know" arrived on the Sparrow label in 1986 and fared well on Billboard's Gospel and Christian charts. It garnered three Grammy nominations. Williams took the award for 'Best Soul Gospel Performance, Female' (*I Surrender All*) and with featured guest Sandi Patty won 'Best Gospel Performance by a Duo or Group, Choir or Chorus' for *They Say*, the solo original version of which appeared on "I'm So Proud."

Williams continued to release secular material, too. Her Gospel recordings for Sparrow resumed in 1989 with "Special Love" and guest appearances on "Children in Praise" by the West Angeles Church of God in Christ Angelic Choir. By the end of the decade, she was nominated for four additional Grammys, winning 'Best Gospel Performance, Female' for *I Believe in You* (off "Water Under the Bridge"). During the '90s, Williams made guest appearances on albums by the likes of Nancy Wilson, George Duke, and Stevie Wonder and


released three Gospel albums on as many labels. "Lullabies to Dreamland" was issued in 1991, trailed five years later by "Love Solves It All." The third one, "This Is My Song," won the 1998 Grammy award for 'Best Pop/Contemporary Gospel Album.'

Nine years passed before her next release, "Love, Niecy Style," on which she covered R&B classics spanning the '60s, '70s, and early '80s. Duke, Wonder, and Earth, Wind & Fire's Philip Bailey were among the collaborators on the album, produced by Bobby Eli, a Philly Soul vet who worked on Williams' early '80s sessions with Thom Bell.

Williams' soaring, four-octave soprano voice made her one of the most distinctive talents to arrive during the Soul era. Since her recording debut in 1968, she established herself in the 70s, first as part of Stevie Wonder's Wonderlove, then as a songwriter, and finally as a solo artist who could also produce and arrange her own material while partnering with R&B and Jazz giants.



Williams, now 75, has continued to perform and act, and has recorded the occasional single, such as the independently released 2020 track *When You Love Somebody*. This was followed by a new EP titled "Gemini," released in the fall of 2021. On June 30, 2021, she was honored as one of the first ever inductees into the Women Songwriters Hall of Fame. In the Spring of 2023, Williams was also bestowed with the keys to the city of Kingston, Jamaica.

The Josie Music Awards (JMAs) stands today as the largest, multi-genre, privately owned independent music awards show in the world, drawing thousands of artists, industry leaders, and fans from across the globe each year. More than an award ceremony, the JMAs have become a thriving hub for networking, collaboration, and lifelong musical friendships.

What began in 2009 with a single brand has grown into a powerful movement championing the strength and resilience of independent artists. The Josie Network of Brands - now 17 strong - is led by the dynamic mother-daughter team of Josie Passantino-Boone (Co-Owner/Brand) and Tinamarie Passantino (Co-Owner/COO). "It has grown so much larger since we first began work in the independent music field," they share. "Our first brand showcased independent talent through radio interviews, live events, and more."

"As always, this was another magical year," Josie and Tinamarie reflect. "We will all make history together by being broadcast on ACN (American Country Network) and later on our own station, JMA Network TV, as the first independent, woman-owned music awards show to be televised."

- The Malpass Brothers receiving the Tex Ritter Award, presented by Tommie Ritter

Independent artists delivered moving performances throughout the evening, including Ashley Jordan, Jasmine Cain, Matt Boone, Jim Brown, Kathryn Shipley & Shane Thornton, Esther June, Carolina Rial, and Tyler Dean McDowell.

A distinguished lineup of presenters added to the night's excitement: Jim Brown, Clarence Jey, Charlene Tilton, John Ford Coley, Deborah Allen, Carl Wayne Meekins, Jake Hoot, Sammy Sadler, Dave Gibson, John Berry, Bobby Tomberlin, Jesse Keith Whitley, Irene Michaels, Christopher Wyze, and sponsor Vic Hill of TheThrill.tv, The Vic Hill Show, and Volunteer Speedway.

"For us, the best part of the night is always seeing the smiles, the joy, the connections being made, and the love everyone has for one another," says Josie Passantino-Boone.

Supporting independent artists remains the heartbeat of the Passantino family. "We love being even a small part of their journey toward the goals they've set for themselves, Josie mentions"

Looking ahead, the JMAs have already confirmed dates for their next major events:


- JMA Music Fest – September 19 at the Gaylord Opryland Resort

The Passantino family has earned a reputation as true friends to independent artists - advocates who believe in them, encourage them, and help amplify their voices.

The JMAs were born out of years spent interviewing thousands of artists on The Josie Show and other programs hosted by Josie and produced by Tinamarie. The show can be heard on iHeartRadio, Spotify, and Amazon Music. Josie began her radio career at just 14 years old, while Tinamarie stepped into the management role that helped shape their now-iconic mother-daughter partnership. Their network continues to expand, including ventures such as Passantino Concert Café, JMA Network TV, and more.

Bobby Chitwood

Faith, Family, and the Road That Built Him

Bobby Chitwood may have Texas roots, but Wyoming has become home. A seasoned Country artist with songs charting on Billboard and the Texas Music Charts, Bobby's journey has been anything but ordinary.

He has weathered the highs and lows of life on the road, including a grueling schedule of over 300 shows a year. That led to a serious vocal injury. But Bobby's faith, family, and loyal fan base gave him the strength to see it as part of God's plan. "I focused on songwriting during that time," he says. After therapy and vocal rest, Bobby returned stronger than ever, releasing a new album "It's Just Me," which is filled with songs that reflect the conservative values he holds dear.

Tracks like *That's Just Me* and *That Dash* speak to character and legacy, while his single *Redneckery* brings a bonfire-season vibe with a playful edge. He also teamed up again with Cowboy Troy for *Twisted*, a rowdy anthem that became a digital hit.

Bobby grew up in Brownwood, Texas, then moved through West Texas and Abilene. "I started playing music pretty young," he recalls. "My grandfather was a Christian singer-songwriter who had a song, *Good Morning God* on Chapel Records back in the sixties. I learned three chords from my mom to play *Good Morning God* on my grandfather's guitar."

By his teens, Bobby was performing regularly. In college, he entered the Jimmy Dean Country Showdown and made it through several rounds. "I caught the music bug from there," he says. "College was kind of my dad's thing but he said, 'I'll support you any way you want me to.'" After college, Bobby hit the road, playing honky-tonks across the country.

Bobby's family has a long history of military service: his dad and grandfather both served with other generations behind them. Bobby is also a veteran. He mentions, "I served three years as artillery." When vocal rest sidelined his music career, he leaned into that background. "Thank you, Dad, for pushing me to stick with it. I still get to do it. I maintain my commercial pilot license, and I still get up in the air."

After graduating college, Bobby had already built a strong presence in the Texas red dirt scene, covering legends like George Strait, Alan Jackson, and Merle Haggard. "Our first show outside of Texas was up in Idaho," he says. "We were still playing covers, and it all went really well in Texas. But apparently, it wasn't good enough for Idaho. They wanted more Rock, and we were playing George Strait!" Booked for a two-week gig, Bobby and his band were let go after the first week for being 'too Country.' "That really blew me away," he says. "A little Texas boy, I was definitely surprised by that!"

But fate had other plans. Bobby's drummer was from Cody, Wyoming, and suggested they play a small club there to earn gas money. "That's actually where I met my wife," Bobby says. "So, I moved to Wyoming."

Bobby appeared on the Dr. Phil Show to share his story as a touring and recording artist on the road. "At that time, I was still touring pretty heavily," Bobby recalls. "I hadn't hit 300 days a year yet, but I was close. We talked about the difficulties, the things you go through as a family. I had two young babies at the time. That's how we ended up on the show. It was eye-opening - hearing his perspective. That appearance was directly tied to the amount of time I was spending on the road."



The new album, "That's Just Me and a Little Redneckery" is filled with tracks from faith, family fun and, of course, being a redneck! "A lot of the songs on the record I wrote myself or with other writers," Bobby says. "But *That's Just Me* - that was going to be a song that was definitely just me. This is who I am."

This time around, Bobby released the record independently. "I didn't have a label behind it, so I had a lot more artistic leeway, to do what I wanted and say what I wanted to say. And *That's Just Me* had to be on the record, for sure."

Chitwood shares insight on the album's tracks. "That Dash," Bobby says, "is one of my favorite songs on the record. A buddy and I were talking. I don't even remember how we got there, but we started talking about how we all have a start date and an end date. And everything else is really defined by that little line between the two numbers. I knew there had to be a song in there." He co-wrote it with Nashville songwriter Cory Barker. "We kicked some ideas back and forth and ended up with that song. I think it just speaks to a lot."

"The track *Redneckery* is a fun song," Bobby laughs. "It was inspired by my daughter. We were talking about the kind of stuff I did growing up in Texas - shooting stuff, being outside all the time - and she said, 'Dad, you're such a redneck.' I never thought of it that way. That's just what we did." They coined the term "redneckery" to describe those moments, and the song was born.

Bobby shares the inspiration of *Little Fuzzy Slippers? Superman, Strong*. "I have two daughters, and they both inspired that song. I started writing it years ago but never put it on a record. When we got into the studio this time, I had just finished it, so it made the cut."

The first single was *Twisted* (feat. Cowboy Troy) "I've known Troy for years," Bobby says. "We first performed together at Cheyenne Frontier Days and became fast friends. When Big & Rich went on hiatus, Troy started his own company, and I was under his management for a bit."

Later, Bobby started writing *Twisted* and thought, 'Man, it'd be cool if Cowboy Troy threw his bit in there.' They traded ideas, and Troy jumped on board. "We were supposed to release the whole record in 2020 or 2021, but we all know what happened then. So, everything got delayed. And here we are now."

"On the track, *Bible and Sweet Tea*, that one was inspired by my daughter too," he adds. "A few years ago, she mentioned something about 'Bible and sweet tea.' I don't know if she saw it when we were visiting family in Texas, but she helped me write that one. She got her first writer credit on it, it's kind of her song."

"Being out on the road is a lot more refined now than it used to be," Bobby explains. "It used to be constant. Now I take dates as they come - in intervals. We're doing some charity events, which I really enjoy."

As for the shows? "They're always high energy. We have a good time. My connection with the crowd just seems to be organic. I've played for 30,000 people and I've played for 300, and they all have their own dynamics. Some of those smaller shows I really enjoy because you can interact with the crowd more. It's a little more personal."

Bobby has partnered with Wounded Warrior Homes, helping build accessible housing for veterans with physical disabilities. He also teamed up with Hydrate Heroes, a sports drink company that donates profits to military and first responders.

"I've got a song called *Everyday Heroes* to support Hydrate Heroes," he says. "They're putting QR codes on their packaging that take you straight to the single. A percentage of both the song and the drink goes to law enforcement, military, and firefighters."

A special moment for him was performing his song, *A Soldier's Battle*. "I wrote that one years ago - just an acoustic version on one of my EPs," Bobby says. "I got to perform it at Congress and the Senate for a Veterans Day event. That one definitely, made an impression."

Bobby - being a husband, father, and a veteran - has relied on his faith even in the tough times to keep him grounded. "There was a time I was kind of separated from my faith," Bobby shares. "And my girls honestly redirected me back toward Christ." He recalls a moment in Denver: "I was super sick in a hotel room. I missed my family. I prayed and said, 'God, I just want a reason to go home.' About three weeks later, my vocal issues started popping up. I wasn't looking to come off the road - I was paying my guys, my crew, the bills. But I knew Christ was there, directing where I needed to be. I needed to be home. I have no doubt my prayers were answered. If we just listen to the Lord, we'll go a long way."

As 2026 approaches, Bobby is planning more charity events and live shows. "I really want to interact with fans more like I used to," he says. "I'm really going to be pushing this new record." With a love for God, family, his country and music, Bobby Chitwood continues to travel down the road that built him.

Anne Murray is a global music icon whose signature voice and timeless catalogue have defined a career spanning over five decades. A trailblazer across Country, Adult Contemporary, and Pop, the Canadian native sold over 55 million albums, earned countless accolades, and became one of the most influential female artists of all time.

From her humble beginnings in Nova Scotia, Murray's passion for music led to early performances across Canada and her debut album "What About Me." In 1969, she signed with Capitol Records and released "This Way Is My Way," featuring *Snowbird* - the breakout hit that made her the first Canadian solo female artist to reach No. 1 on the U.S. charts and earn Gold certification.

Throughout the 1970s and 1980s, Murray's crossover success continued with hits like *Danny's Song*, *You Needed Me*, *Shadows in the Moonlight*, *Broken Hearted Me*, *Daydream Believer*, *Could I Have This Dance*, *A Little Good News*, and *Just Another Woman in Love*. Her music resonated across genres and generations.

Her accolades include four Grammys, 26 JUNO Awards (the most in history), three American Music Awards, and multiple honors from the CMA and CCMA. She is a Companion of the Order of Canada and was recently awarded the 2025 JUNO Lifetime Achievement Award. Her star shines on the Hollywood Walk of Fame, Nashville's Walkway of Stars, and Canada's Walk of Fame, with inductions into several Halls of Fame.

Murray's influence paved the way for Canadian artists like Céline Dion, Shania Twain, K.D. Lang, Alanis Morissette, and Sarah McLachlan. With 32 studio albums, 15 compilations, over 1 billion global streams, and tours spanning the U.S., UK, Australia, Europe, and beyond, her reach remains unmatched.

On October 27, the Opry House hosted The Music of My Life - An All-Star Tribute to Anne Murray, featuring Trisha Yearwood, Martina McBride, K.D. Lang, Kathy Mattea, Lorrie Morgan, Pam Tillis, Shenandoah, The Gatlin Brothers, Collin Raye, Natalie Grant, Michelle Wright, Victoria Shaw, and appearances by Brenda Lee, Randy Travis, and Barry Trotz.

To celebrate her 80th birthday, Murray announced her 33rd studio album "Here You Are," released September 5, 2025. The project features 11 unreleased tracks recorded



between 1978 and 1995, revitalized by Grammy-winning producer Bob Rock and mixer Adam Greenholtz. Highlights include *Rest Easy (In My Love)*, *Bring All Your Heartaches to Me*, and *Straight From the Heart*, with new background vocals by Anne and her daughter Dawn, and fresh instrumentation by her nephew Dale. The album's cover showcases a 1971 painting by Canadian artist Harley Brown. Available on CD and vinyl - including a limited gold edition with signed lithograph - "Here You Are" expands Murray's legacy with music that bridges past and present.

Beyond the stage, Murray's philanthropic work includes the Anne Murray Centre, a charitable foundation and museum she continues to oversee. Her legacy as a groundbreaker, mentor, and national treasure remains firmly intact.







Johan Smits (aka John Smyths) was born in March 1961 in the old town of Nijmegen and was introduced to the world of music by his parents and older brother. Although it wasn't the kind of music he liked, it was music.

When his wild years were over, he got more and more into country music and listened to Conway Twitty, Hank Williams, Waylon Jennings, Kenny Rogers, Tammy Wynette and so on. Moving to Germany, he would go to the studio regularly to record covers of some well-known country songs, even recorded three of his own songs and was on stage several times, mostly in Germany and Belgium. While he might have only started releasing music on digital platforms under the moniker John Smyths, Johan Smits has been sharing singles for years – so he's not all that much of a newbie on the scene.

Raised on a diet of Kiss, Van Halen, Iron Maiden and AC/DC, Smyths found a base in the oldschool rock scene; however, he's not afraid to saunter across different genres and found himself wading through country music with Hank Williams, Kenny Rogers and Waylon Jennings.

For 2025, John Smyths was on stage in Viechtach (Bavaria), Gerolstein, Stolberg, Wolfhagen, Nijmegen (NL) and many more. He has been awarded for his song “Loving You Makes Me A Better Man” at the Red Carpet Show International in Wageningen (NL) where he also was on stage. Another nomination was done by “the Elite Music Awards” in the States. He released his single at the end of August, called “Now I'm Wiser” which got great critics all over the world. And now getting back with “Last Night” which is a beautiful Country ballad.
