

orn in the Southern coalfields of West Virginia, by the age of two Morgan White had already begun exhibiting a musical talent which would become her life-long passion. With a baby bottle in one hand and a microphone in the other, she performed at local nursing homes where her mother would stand her in a chair, and she would sing classic Gospel songs.

Influenced by legends like Reba McEntire, Dolly Parton, Martina McBride, LeAnn Rimes and Carrie Underwood... Morgan is a true vocal stylist. This sassy, strikingly powerful, ultra- entertainer is bound and determined to follow in the footsteps of these greats. While she has some pretty big shoes to fill, this little lady is up for the challenge. Morgan has always known that singing would carry her far beyond the Appalachian peaks that she calls home. Referred to as a modern day "Coal Miner's Daughter," her first album entitled "I'm Gone" produced two number one singles. The album's title track, I'm Gone remained at the top of the charts for recording contract with MC1 Nashville/Sony Orchard and twelve consecutive weeks on Hot Country Radio in the Carolinas.

In the fall of 2009, Morgan headed south to Nashville, Tennessee to begin her pursuit of a recording contract. A year later, she was contacted by a well-known industry engineer who told her that her efforts were paying off. Morgan soon met with Elbert West, a multi-talented, Nashvillebased Producer/Singer/Songwriter and was signed to MooTown Records in November of 2010. She remained on the label for the next year and a half crafting her songwriting skills and gaining knowledge about the business.

In 2017, Morgan released her selftitled sophomore album. The album, all co-penned by White, is a blend of modern Country and the classic, all American sound Morgan's fans have grown to love. The first nationally released single, Sad and Lonely, with its soaring chorus, has garnered national attention on several music industry charts and media outlets. Morgan was nominated for six Josie Music Awards, including: 'Female Artist of the Year,' 'Female Vocalist of the Year,' 'Album of the Year,' 'Entertainer of The Year,' 'Song of the Year' for Sad and Lonely, and 'Music Video of the Year.'

2019 was another huge year for Morgan. She signed a released her brand new single, Good Thing Gone. The single,



hitting Music Row and national radio stations worldwide, was written by Nashville hit songwriters Carly Pearce, Joel Shewmake, and Allison Veltz. Produced by Hit Producer Sal Oliveri (Chris Stapleton/ Pink, *Love Me Anyway*), this sassy anthem takes Morgan to the grittier side of her Country roots. Morgan wrapped up her 2019 Tour at the Josie Music Awards with three nominations and taking home the coveted 'Female Entertainer of the Year' award.

2020 was a very difficult time for many in the music industry, but true to Morgan's style, she continued pressing forward. She took the time to immerse herself in the recording studio and in her songwriting. She inked a deal with NashTown Entertainment and is poised to take Country music radio by storm with her highly anticipated, new single, *Take Me*. Written by Nashville hit songwriters, Kelleigh Bannen and Scooter Carosue, this single highlights Morgan's softer, flirtier side. Produced by multi-platinum and Grammy nominated producer, Sal Oliveri in Brentwood, Tennessee, *Take Me* is sure to be a summer anthem for Country music fans worldwide.






"I'm so excited to let people hear my new music!" she stated. "I just want to be true to myself and to my fans, and this new music allows me to do that."

Where Are They Now?

A Retrospective Glimpse at Yesterday's Rising Music Stars
Who Became Icons and Where They Are Today

THIS EDITION: The Band Perry • Clay Aiken

The Band Perry

Kimberly Perry sang in her own band as a teenager with her brothers, Reid and Neil, working as roadies. At ages eight and ten the brothers began performing as an opening act, the Mobile Music Machines, for Kimberly. Once they had united to form as The Band Perry, they joined the 'New Faces of Country' tour in 2005. They were discovered by Garth Brooks' manager, Bob Doyle.

The Band Perry released their self-titled debut album in October 2010, with Republic Nashville. From this album, *If I Die Young* reached number one on the Country and Adult Contemporary charts and was certified 6x multi-platinum. Their second album, "Pioneer," produced additional number one singles in *Better Dig Two* and *Done*, plus the top ten hits *Don't Let Me Be Lonely* and *Chainsaw*.

They recorded a cover of the Glen Campbell hit, *Gentle on My Mind*, for the documentary about the singer titled "Glen Campbell: I'll Be Me," which was released as a standalone single. The Band Perry was CMA's 2011 'Single' and 'Song of the Year.' The band also earned 'Best New Artist' at the CMAs and ACMs. The band performed in the pre-game show of Super Bowl XLVIII on Sunday, February 2, 2014.

In July 2016, Neil, Reid, and Kimberly appeared on Celebrity Family Feud with host Steve Harvey.

On February 2, 2017, the band announced the title of their third album, "My Bad Imagination." Unlike their previous

two albums, this one would be pop. They said, "Creating it has been the most exciting thing we've ever done."

In the summer of 2018, the band left Interscope Records/Mercury Nashville to release music independently. On September 21, the band released a five-song collection called "Coordinates" via ARTRAT, their newly formed creative house. The band wrote and produced all five songs themselves while Rick Rubin oversaw the project as executive producer.



"Our mission is to be exactly who we are and be able to put it out in real time," Kimberly told Billboard. She reiterated that sentiment to Rolling Stone, saying, "Now, we're not chasing money. We're chasing ourselves." The Bands latest radio release is *Nite Swim*.

Clay Aiken

As a young boy, Clay Aiken sang in the Raleigh Boys choir; and, as a teenager, he sang in school choirs, church choir, musicals and local theatre productions. After high school, he sang lead with a local band, Just By Chance. He performed the national anthem numerous



times for the Raleigh IceCaps and the Carolina Hurricanes hockey teams and performed it at the 2011 NHL All-Star Game at the RBC Center in Raleigh. Three demo albums of

Aiken's vocals were created before American Idol with the aid of studio time given as a birthday gift by his mother.

Aiken learned quickly that he could make a difference in the lives of young people. He found his interest in special education while directing YMCA children's camps as a teenager, and at age 19, he served as a substitute teacher for a classroom of autistic students. While attending college in Charlotte, he took a part-time job as an assistant to a boy with autism, and it was this child's mother, Diane Bubel, who urged him to audition for American Idol. Although his American Idol activities temporarily delayed his academic pursuits, Aiken completed his course work while on tour and graduated with a bachelor's degree in Special Education in December 2003.

Aiken finished second place on the second season of American Idol in 2003. His debut album, "Measure of a Man," went multi-platinum. He released four more albums on the RCA label, "Merry Christmas with Love" (2004), "A Thousand Different Ways" (2006), the Christmas EP "All is Well" (2006) and "On My Way Here" (2008). Since then, he has released two more albums, both with Decca Records: "Tried and True" (2010) and "Steadfast" (2012.) Aiken has also had eleven tours in support of his albums. In all, he has sold over five million albums, and is the fourth highest-selling American Idol alumnus.

Aiken co-wrote a bestselling memoir in 2004, "Learning to Sing," and had a televised Christmas special, A Clay Aiken Christmas. During much of 2008 he appeared on Broadway in the musical comedy Spamalot, in the role of Sir Robin. In




2010 he hosted the PBS special Tried & True Live! He has also had numerous cameo and guest appearances on TV shows. In 2012 he competed in the fifth season of The Celebrity Apprentice, coming in second to Arsenio Hall. Aiken hasn't released new music since 2012.

With Diane Bubel, Aiken created the

Bubel/Aiken Foundation which was later renamed the National Inclusion Project. In 2004 he became a UNICEF ambassador, a position he held until 2013 when he gave it up in order to run for Congress. He traveled extensively in this role. In 2006, he was appointed for a two-year term to the Presidential Committee for People with Intellectual Disabilities. In 2014, Aiken ran for the United States House of Representatives in North Carolina's 2nd congressional district. He won the Democratic primary but lost to Republican incumbent Renee Ellmers in the general election.







John McDonough

Second Chances

John McDonough knows what he's doing in the music business. He has played guitar since his teens and been singing since childhood. He recently relocated from Austin, Texas to Chicago, Illinois to take advantage of new musical opportunities and be closer to his family.

John McDonough worked as a psychotherapist but retired in 2011 to focus on his music. Since then, he has released five CDs of original music, played over 500 gigs and appeared at eleven music festivals, including Bastille Days in Milwaukee, which he thinks is the biggest festival he has played to date. He has also appeared on local and national radio and television channels and toured the United States. He previously released eight CDs over a 25-year period while living and working in Austin.

He is proud to be able to say that his three previous releases, "Dreams and Imagination," "Surrounding Colors," and "Can You See Me Now" all spent at least six months in the Americana Radio Chart in the US. His current release, an acoustic CD called "Second Chances," is also charting and receiving favorable reviews. It contains acoustic versions of songs he has previously recorded, including *The Place Where I Belong* which is about John Denver. The original version, from "Surrounding Colors," reached number one on the Indieworld Country Record Report. The acoustic version rose to number three on the iTunes South Africa Pop Chart and number nine on the iTunes South Africa Chart in all genres.

Unsurprisingly, perhaps, given that reception, "Second Chances" has been nominated for 'Album of the Year' (male) for the 2021 Josie Music Awards. The arrangements are for two acoustic guitars, two vocals, and a string section. All his

releases since 2012 are available for paid download from his website as well as on Spotify, Amazon and iTunes.

McDonough describes his influences as acoustic singersongwriters such as James Taylor, Cat Stevens, Crosby Stills and Nash and Harry Chapin. After a stint at music college in his mid-20s he began to take songwriting, recording and performing more seriously, alongside his career as a psychotherapist.

His website showcases one of his many songs: *Planes Fly Too Low*. No, it's not about what you think it is. And the video is drone footage of coastal areas to make you fly when you're confined to your home in a shelter-in-place order and can only dream of escaping somewhere like that. There are also a number of videos of original songs and cover versions and a list of his forthcoming shows in Illinois and Wisconsin.

McDonough says he enjoys playing live when he can, although this has been curtailed due to the pandemic. He likes to talk about his songs and bring the audience with him on his journey, giving them some background to each piece. This isn't always possible, depending on where he's playing, but he tries his best. He's not the first musician to find that playing in bars and restaurants can be challenging, as the audience's primary focus is not on listening to the music. Even so, he remembers a small show in Texas where the audience included a couple with their adult son, who was non-verbal


and autistic. The son's reaction to the song *Nowhere Else To Run* was quite loud and disruptive. This reaction did not initially seem to be appropriate for a song which is about the Neue Wache monument in Berlin where an unknown concentration camp victim and an unknown soldier are buried together. However, his mom later told McDonough that her son had understood the song's lyrics, about the conversation the two characters were having, and was expressing his satisfaction in the only way he could.

Despite his music being very easy on the ear, John McDonough has not shied away from tackling some big topics in his lyrics. Politically and socially aware, he has written not only *Nowhere Else To Run*, as mentioned above, but also

lyrics about a gay activist, a heterosexual Christian male, and a black civil rights leader among others. He also continually tries to hone his musical and songwriting skills, as well as sharing the history and stories which led him to write some of the songs.

John McDonough allows his experience to shine through his songs. Now that he is free to concentrate on his music in retirement, listeners can expect more of the same considered, measured lyrics and hummable melodies. He's working on a new CD so the wait shouldn't be too long.

BILL ANDERSON

Celebrating 60 Years on the Grand Ole Opry

hispering Bill," a nickname hung on him years ago as a result of his breathy voice and his warm, soft approach to singing a Country song. Bill Anderson is one of the most awarded songwriters in the history of Country music, a million-selling recording artist many times over, television game show host, author of four books, and a consummate onstage performer. His backup group, The Po' Folks Band, has long been considered one of the finest instrumental and vocal groups in the business.

Bill was born in Columbia, South Carolina, but grew up around Atlanta, Georgia. He worked his way through college as a disc jockey. While still in school he began performing and writing songs. At the age of nineteen, he composed the Country classic, *City Lights* and began rapidly carving his place in musical history.

Anderson moved to Nashville, secured a recording contract with Decca Records, and began recording hit songs like *Po'Folks, Mama Sang A Song, The Tips Of My Fingers* and the crossover smash, *Still.* His songs were recorded by such iconic musical artists as Ray Price, Porter Wagoner, James Brown, Debbie Reynolds, Kitty Wells, Faron Young, Lawrence Welk, Dean Martin, Jerry Lee Lewis, Aretha Franklin, and many others.

The 1980s saw Anderson's chart-topping career take a hiatus as he became a TV network game show host, spokesman for a national restaurant chain, and a nonstop touring Grand Ole Opry performer. Anderson can add acting

and hosting to his long list of accomplishments. He also appeared as himself for three years on ABC's Daytime soap opera, "One Life To Live." For six years he hosted a Country music game show "Fandango," also an interview show called "Opry Backstage," and co-produced "You Can Be A Star," on the Nashville Network. For seven years he hosted the acclaimed "Bill Anderson Visits With The Legends" show on XM satellite radio, and for 23 years headlined the Country's Family Reunion series on RFD-TV.

Bill published his first autobiography, "Whisperin' Bill," in 1989. Then his second book, a humorous look at the music business titled, "I Hope You're Living As High On The Hog As The Pig You Turned Out To Be," was published in 1993 and is currently in its twelfth printing. Bill updated his autobiography with noted Nashville journalist, Peter Cooper, titled "Whisperin' Bill Anderson - An Unprecedented Life In Country Music."

Bill continued writing many hits. He co-wrote giant hits for Vince Gill, (Which Bridge To Cross, Which Bridge To Burn), Steve Wariner (Two Teardrops), Mark Wills (Wish You Were Here), Joe Nichols (I'll Wait For You) and Kenny Chesney (A Lot Of Things Different). He won 'Song Of The Year' honors in both 2005 and 2007 for helping to write Whiskey Lullaby for Brad Paisley and Allison Krauss and Give It Away for George Strait. Both Give It Away and Two Teardrops afforded Anderson Grammy nominations. He also won a Dove award for co-writing the 'Country/Gospel Recorded Song of the Year,' Jonah, Job, and Moses for the

Oak Ridge Boys. He was awarded the CMA 'Vocal Event of the Year' for, Too Country, which he co-wrote and recorded vocal and instrumental versions of some of his best-known with Brad Paisley, George Jones, and Buck Owens.

Bill has been awarded 'Songwriter Of The Year' six times, 'Male Vocalist Of The Year,' and 'Duet Of The Year' with both Jan Howard and Mary Lou Turner. He is a member of the Nashville Songwriters Hall of Fame, Georgia Music Hall of Fame and the Georgia Broadcasters Hall of Fame. His home state of South Carolina inducted him into their Music and Entertainment Hall of Fame. The ultimate honor was the induction into the Country Music Hall of Fame in 2001.

BMI named Anderson its first 'Country Music Songwriting Icon,' placing him alongside R&B legends Little Richard, Chuck Berry, Bo Diddley, and James Brown as the only recipients of that prestigious award at the time. In 2008, the Academy of Country Music honored him with their inaugural 'Poets Award.' In 2018, he was voted membership in the all-genre Songwriters Hall Of Fame and became only the second recipient of the 'Kris Kristofferson Lifetime Achievement Award' from the Nashville Songwriters' Association. The initial award went to Willie Nelson in 2012. In 2021, his composition, Once A Day, was awarded a place in the Library of Congress' prestigious National Recording Registry, where his name now rests alongside such legendary composers as George Gershwin, Irving Berlin, Bob Dylan, and Hank Williams.

He continues to write and record, his latest release being songs, titled "Bill Anderson - The Hits Re-Imagined." Anderson ended the challenging year of 2020 with his latest single and video, It's A Good Day To Have A Good Day.

Now celebrating his 60th year as a member of the Grand Ole Opry he continues performing there regularly. The Opry helped Bill celebrate his 60th Anniversary on Saturday, July 17th. The Opry was broadcasted on WSM Radio, Opry.com and televised on Circle Network. Many of Bill's Country music friends came to help the legend celebrate this milestone including Vince Gill, Mark Wills, and Sara Evans along with many more that were influenced by the Country Music Hall of Famer. Anderson wowed the audiences with several of his classic hits. He shared a special song he wrote called, Thankful. This song shows Bill's thankfulness about his life, his family, his legendary career and all the fans. "I tell people sometimes, the Opry to a Country music singer is like Yankee Stadium to a baseball player," he says. "It's the top rung on the ladder. You just can't get any higher than that."

shley Puckett was born and raised in North on February 14, 2020, with first single, Medicine having been released in August 2019. The single charted nationally on the IndieWorld Country Record Report and Airplay Today Country charts.

> New single, Bulletproof was released on January 9th, 2020, Ashley's birthday. The song raced to the top of the iTunes Country singles chart in South Africa, also becoming a #1 radio hit on the New Music Weekly Country chart.

> "I've never given up on where I wanted to be (in the music industry), however, when life pulls you in so many different directions, it sometimes takes you off-guard, and it becomes very easy to lose sight. I believe everything happens for a reason, and although I feel I'm always at the wrong place at the wrong time, somehow that led me to the right place at the right time, to say 'It's now or never' after meeting Bryan and Doug. The energy the three of us have, working together, and their dedication is so exciting... I know this is just the beginning of something spectacular."

ir Elton John is one of the most highly acclaimed and successful solo artists of all time. He is the multiple Grammy-winning legend and flamboyant superstar of his generation. Elton has achieved 40 platinum or multi-platinum, and 23 gold albums, over 50 Top 40 hits, and he has sold more than 300 million records worldwide. Since launching his first tour in 1970, Elton has performed in more than 80 countries to his credit. He holds the record for the biggest selling single of all time, *Candle In The Wind* in 1997, which sold over 33 million copies.

John has received five Grammy Awards, five Brit Awards; including for Outstanding Contribution to Music; two Academy Awards, two Golden Globes, a Tony Award, a Disney Legends Award, and the Kennedy Center Honor. In 2004, He was inducted into the Songwriters Hall of Fame in 1992 and the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame in 1994, and is a fellow of the British Academy of Songwriters, Composers and Authors. He was knighted by Queen Elizabeth II for "services to music and charitable services" in 1998.

Elton John was born in 1947, near London England. At the age of three he astonished his family by sitting at the piano and playing *The Skater's Waltz* by ear. At the age of 11 he was awarded a scholarship as a Junior Exhibitor at the Royal Academy of Music and he attended the Academy on Saturday mornings for the next four years.

John had formed Bluesology, an R&B band from 1964 until 1967. Two years later, John's debut album, Empty Sky, was released. In 1970, his first hit single, *Your Song*, from his second album, "Elton John", reached the top ten in the UK and the US. The hit songs followed for decades including. *Rocket Man, Crocodile Rock, Goodbye Yellow Brick Rock, Bennie And The Jets, Can You Feel The Love Tonight, Circle Of Life* and the list goes on.


Many of Johns iconic songs was co-written with his longtime musical partner Bernie Taupin since 1967. During that time John and Taupin has collaborated on more than 30 albums. Their method involves Taupin writing the lyrics on his own and sending them to John, who then writes music for them before recording the songs; the two are never in the same room during the process. In November 2017, John said of their 50-year partnership, "We've never ever had an argument



professionally or personally, which is extraordinary because most songwriters sometimes split up because they get jealous of each other. And it's exciting because it's never changed from the first day we wrote songs. I still write the song when he's not there and then I go and play it to him. So the excitement is still the same as it was from day one and that's kept it fresh and it's kept it exciting." In 1992, along with Taupin, John was inducted into the Songwriter's Hall of Fame. He is a fellow of the British Academy of Songwriters, Composers and Authors.

The much anticipated movie "Rocketman" a biopic about John's life from his childhood to the 1980s hit theaters across the nation in the Spring of 2019. The biopic was produced by Paramount Pictures. It was directed by Dexter Fletcher, who had also directed Bohemian Rhapsody (a biopic about John's close friend Freddie Mercury). The movie stared Taron Egerton as John. John and Egerton performed a new song written for Rocketman, "(I'm Gonna) Love Me Again." The song would see John win the Academy Award for Best Original Song for the second time. John released what he described as his "first and only autobiography", "Me" in October 2019. The audiobook was narrated by "Rocketman" actor Taron Egerton, with John reading the Prologue and Epilogue.

Elton John says, "It's time to come off the road so I can fully embrace the next important chapter of my life." It is with great excitement that Elton announces the final dates for his award-winning Farewell Yellow Brick Road: The Final Tour in North America and Europe.




Elton will conclude his world-famous tour at major stadiums which will kick off on May 27, 2022 in Frankfurt. Follow by many major cities in Europe. Elton will then take his final bow in North America, playing in major cities. 



A formal induction ceremony for Bayers, Charles, Drake and The Judds will take place at the Country Music Hall of Fame and Museum in the CMA Theater at a date to-be-determined.

Metallica Donates \$50,000 to Support Haiti Earthquake Relief Efforts



Metallica announced that its All Within My Hands Foundation has donated \$50,000 to aid earthquake relief in Haiti following a recent devastating temblor.

"At least 2,207 have died, over 12k injured and

50k homes destroyed by the devastating 7.2 quake," the organization wrote in a tweet announcing the donation.

According to Direct Relief, the August 14 quake has caused significant damage to critical infrastructure on the island and injured more than 12,000. The situation was exacerbated by a second disaster in the form of tropical depression Grace, which subsequently caused flooding in quake-affected communities. The organization said post-storm flooding and lack of shelter, and

access to clean water and sanitation have drastically increased the risk of the spread of COVID-19, cholera and other diseases.

Experts say the residents of the island are in desperate need of medical relief, tents, hygiene kits and PPE. In the wake of the quake, artists including Cardi B, Don Omar, Steven Van Zandt sent their thoughts and prayers, with Cardi tweeting, "I got a soft spot for Haiti and its people. They my cousins. I pray for Haiti they go thru soo much. God please cover that land and its people."

Omar also addressed the disaster, tweeting in Spanish, "In times of tragedy we have been a united people who have managed to move forward, now is the time to unite and help in this tragedy #Haiti."

Haiti is still recovering from a 5.9 earthquake in 2018 that killed more than a dozen people, and a 7.1 magnitude quake in 2010 that damaged the impoverished country's capital and killed an estimated 300,000 people, according to the Associated Press. The country is also in the midst of a political crisis following July's assassination of President Jovenel Moïse.





ABBA Releases New Music and Hyping Major Reunion 'Voyage'

Dancing Queen fans have been anxiously awaiting the first new music in nearly four decades from the iconic Swedish Pop band which has earned a reported \$2 billion in a career that's spanned arena stages, 400 million records sold, the Broadway stage and movie screens.

The act's new official Twitter account dropped a bombshell, cryptically hyping an upcoming chance for fans to witness a reunion "Voyage" of some mysterious sort. This *Mamma Mia* of a big comeback tease is accompanied by a website for the mystery project, and the opportunity to "Register your interest to be the first in line to hear more about ABBA Voyage."



All this dropped with the requisite Facebook, Twitter and Instagram links that group mates Agnetha Fältskog, Björn Ulvaeus, Benny Andersson and Anni-Frid Lyngstad never dreamed of when ABBA launched in 1972.

The "Voyage" is expected to be a long-gestating "hologram tour" that ABBA initially announced in 2016, BBC reported. The band is also expected to release five new songs and a documentary as companion pieces to the show.

Björn, 76, Benny, 74, Agnetha, 71, and Anni-Frid, 75, have joined forces with "American Idol" mastermind Simon Fuller to bring the ideas to life, according to an insider who spilled some "huge" tea on the Sun.

"Fans should hold on to their hats because this is going to be one wild ride," the tipster gushed. "Björn, Benny, Agnetha and Anni-Frid will all be there on the opening night, and they will finally unveil their Abba-tars, which are like holograms of

themselves. The show will feature the Abba-tars performing and speaking to the audience. It will be like taking a step back in time for those watching."

Now, the quartet plans to release three bonus tracks to thank fans for their patience, with Ulvaeus confirming the music will "definitely" come out this year. "It's not a case any more of it might happen, it will happen," he told the Herald Sun, while teasing a possible reunion tour.

After taking the top prize at the Eurovision Song Contest with *Waterloo* in 1974, ABBA went on to sell nearly 400 million singles and albums around the globe. Their last recording sessions as a band were in 1982, but their music has lived on in the soundtracks to the cult hit 1994 film "Muriel's Wedding" and the smash international stage musical "Mamma Mia!," which also spawned a pair of hit big-screen adaptations starring Meryl Streep and Cher.



Since the Jonas Brothers formation in 2005 the trio has been critically adored and commercially celebrated with over 22 million album sales, sold-out stadium tours, and major film appearances. Now they are enjoying the success of the 'Remember This' tour, new music, and their soon released autobiography. Cashbox Magazine celebrates the talents and extraordinary career of the band of brothers that changed the course of music forever.

These New Jersey boys wrote their first record and released it on Hollywood Records in 2005. In mid-2008, they starred in the Disney Channel original movie Camp Rock and its sequel, Camp Rock 2: The Final Jam. They also starred as Kevin, Joe, and Nick Lucas from the band, Jonas, in their own Disney Channel series. Fans sang along with songs like, *Year 3000, SOS, Burnin' Up* and *Lovebug* just to name a few.

The group was nominated for a Grammy award for 'Best New Artist.' The brothers took home the award for 'Breakthrough Artist' at the American Music Awards.

The band has released five albums: "It's About Time" (2006), "Jonas Brothers" (2007), "A Little Bit Longer" (2008), "Lines, Vines and Trying Times" (2009), and "Happiness Begins" (2019).

In 2011, the brothers took a hiatus to focus on their solo careers. Then, on October 29, 2013, the Jonas Brothers officially confirmed their split. They planned a fifth album titled "V" but the project was shelved. The guys didn't want to leave their fans without new music, so they released a new live album of hits.

Six years following their split, the group reunited with the release of *Sucker* in March of 2019 on Republic Records. The song became the 34th song in history to debut at number one on the Billboard Hot 100. It sold 88,000 copies its first week, becoming the Jonas Brothers' first number one song. Their fifth studio album, "Happiness Begins," was released that same year, topping the US Charts. This was followed up by a documentary titled 'Chasing Happiness,' which premiered on June 4 on Amazon Prime. More singles followed in 2020, *What a Man Gotta Do* and *Five More Minutes*.

The Jonas Brothers are currently on their eleventh headlining tour, the 'Remember This' Tour, consisting of 44 shows at outdoor venues around the United States. Kelsea Ballerini has been their special guest for a majority of shows. The single *Remember This* premiered on June 18 and was used in NBC's coverage of the 2020 Summer Olympics. They recorded the song *Mercy* for the soundtrack of Space Jam: A New Legacy which was released on July 9th.

Individually, each brother has carved their own path of success. Joe released his debut album "Fastlife," then he formed the Funk-Pop band DNCE in 2015 as the lead vocalist. The group saw the significant commercial success of their debut single *Cake by the Ocean*. In 2018, Joe joined the Australian version of The Voice as a coach. Jonas and British DJ Jonas Blue released their collaborative track *I See Love*, a song for the film Hotel Transylvania 3: Summer Vacation. He also voiced a character called Kraken in the movie. Joe got married to English actress Sophie Turner in 2019 and they have a daughter.



Nick embarked on a 2011 tour with his band Nick Jonas & the Administration who released the album "Who I Am" in 2010. Afterward, Jonas shifted his focus to acting and had a recurring role on the television series, Smash. Nick

continued to release solo projects. He appeared in the adventure comedy film Jumanji: Welcome to the Jungle, which became the fifth highest-grossing film of the year. Nick was the coach on NBC's The Voice for two seasons. He relieved a fourth studio album, "Spaceman" with singles, *Spaceman* and *This Is Heaven* released earlier this year. he Scotts, who began as The Scott Singers, was a local, Traditional Gospel group out of Franklin, Virginia, just 43 miles southwest of Norfolk. Comprised of all family members, The Scotts sang and performed in local churches and events throughout Southeastern Virginia and Northeastern North Carolina. The Scotts gained much notoriety and became a household name within a 100-mile radius of their hometown. The group had the dedication, musical talent, and passion. The only thing they were missing was an opportunity.

One night in the late 1980s, Jerry was scheduled to sing alongside The Scotts in Newport News, Virginia, but decided to skip out on the group's performance. Instead, he went to hear Charles Johnson and The Revivers sing at Shiloh Baptist Church in Boykins, Virginia, a small town not too far away from his hometown of Franklin. Jerry had no idea the introductions and connections that would become of missing The Scotts' performance. After the concert, Jerry talked with Darrell Luster, a member of The Revivers who eventually introduced him to Dwight Gordon, the former guitar player for the famed Gospel quartets, The Williams Brothers and The Mighty Clouds of Joy.

Dwight would end up producing The Scotts' album "Greatest Thing," which became the launching pad for their recognition and future success. Dwight also introduced Jerry to Tim Greene, who signed The Scotts to their first major deal with Gloryland Records.

JERRY SCOTT

The Right Place at the Right Time

From small town fame to global household name, Southern Gospel's first black family has quite the success story. It was the lead singer of the group, Jerry Scott, who was directly responsible for the evolution of The Scotts.

impressed with their anointing and talent, he offered to release their song *Praise Your Name*, written by Jerry, for his radio promotion, Showcase Media. As a result, Praise Your Name charted at #77 in the Southern Gospel music magazine, The Singing News.

The following year, while The Scotts were in Nashville, Tennessee for The National Quartet Convention - a six-day convention featuring performances from popular names in Southern Gospel - Brian Hudson showcased them in a nearby mall one afternoon. Little did they know, their performance would grab the attention of an iconic artist in Southern Gospel, who happened to be present at that same mall.

Later that night, Jerry, without his siblings, decided to attend the coliseum in Nashville, where The National Convention was held. There, he saw performances by various groups - one of which was Karen Peck and New River, best known for hits like *Daddy's Home*, *Four Days Late* and *Hope* For All Nations. After their performance, Jerry found his way backstage to the group to personally congratulate Karen on an amazing performance. Much to his surprise, she also wanted to congratulate him and The Scotts. She was in the mall earlier that day and witnessed firsthand the anointing, talent and stage presence The Scotts possessed. Completely taken aback, Jerry was personally ushered by Karen to the Century II Promotions booth, a booking agency co-owned by Beckie Simmons.

Jerry happened to have a cassette tape of The Scotts in In 1993, Tim introduced Jerry to Brian Hudson, the talent his pocket, which he handed over to Beckie. She played it and asked Jerry if he could come back to Nashville in few days to meet with her. He agreed to return, this time only bringing his parents, the late Bishop Clinton L. and Mother Bernice Scott, and one of his older brothers, Herbert. Jerry signed an

exclusive booking and management contract with Century II Promotions. That is when The Scotts exploded.

The Scotts took their talents to Europe in 1995 to perform at Christian Cultural Week in Bielskie, Poland - making them the first Gospel group to ever perform in the newly democratic country. While there, they also performed in Warsaw and Krakow.

In 1996, Beckie Simmons introduced Jerry to Bill

notable performances include: All Night Gospel Sing in Bonifay, Florida; Grand Ole Opry Jubilee in Tennessee: Nashville, Albert Brumley's Sun Up to Sundown Gospel Sing in Springdale, Arkansas; various performances in areas in Canada such as Truro, Nova Scotia; Monckton and Fredericton, New Brunswick: and the annual Mississippi State Fair both in 1995 and 1996. While under contract with Century II Promotions, The Scotts went on to perform 145 - 175 dates per year from 1994 to 1997.


Personal struggles, a deathly ill father and contractual disputes resulted in a ten-year hiatus for The Scotts. The hiatus gave both the group, and the Scott family, some much needed time to heal from the deaths of multiple close relatives. The group has continued to evolve and are back performing, using other family members and a few hired musicians to complete their sound.



Biz Markie *April 8, 1964 – July 16, 2021*

Biz Markie, whose real name was Marcel Theo Hall, was born in Harlem on April 8, 1964. He grew up on Long Island and graduated from Longwood High School in 1982. He said that his nickname was inspired by the first hip-hop tape he heard as a boy. Markie launched his music career in New York City but later moved to Maryland after gaining fame on the college circuit in the Washington, D.C. Area.

Markie, who was often called the "clown prince of hip hop," is best known for his iconic 1989 single, *Just a Friend,* which became a top 40 song in several countries. The single, which samples the 1968 Freddie Scott tune, (*You*) Got What I Need, was certified platinum in 1990.

Markie moved to television and film appearances throughout the 2000s, including portraying a beatboxing alien in "Men in Black II" and himself in "Empire." Besides his acting and composing, Markie also loved collecting unique clothes, toys and shoes. In addition to Beanie Babies, he told The Washington Post in 2019 he had "the Six Million Dollar Man, paralympic Barbie, 'Welcome Back, Kotter' dolls, the Fonz action figure, the Munsters," and every Barbie ever made.

He also said that people would "always sing" his iconic hit single to him when they saw him in public. "The weirdest thing about my fame is that when I'm thinking that it's almost over it just sparks back up," he told the Post. "I made *Just a Friend* in '89. Some people's records die - it sprouts up. Now it's thirty years later and it's sprouted up again in commercials. They're not letting me die. The public, the fans, they like me around."

Biz Markie, the charismatic rapper who's infectious 1989 single *Just a Friend* became a pop culture classic, passed away on July 16, 2021, his manager confirmed in a statement. He was 57 years old.

"It is with profound sadness that we announce, with his wife Tara by his side, Hip Hop pioneer Biz Markie peacefully passed away," the statement said. Markie had a history of health issues. Last year, he was hospitalized in Maryland and treated for complications that are a part of his history with Type II diabetes.

"Biz created a legacy of artistry that will forever be celebrated by his industry peers and his beloved fans whose lives he was able to touch through music, spanning over 35 years," the statement added. "He leaves behind a wife, many family members and close friends who will miss his vibrant personality, constant jokes and frequent banter."



Dusty Hill May 19, 1949 – July 28, 2021

Dusty Hill was ZZ Top's bassist for more than fifty years. While ZZ Top was best known for their synthesizer-powered 1980s hits, they were a thoroughly Texan, Heavy Rock-Blues band at heart, spawned from the same psychedelic scene that birthed Roky Erickson and the 13th Floor Elevators but keeping things roots and rocking throughout their more than 50-year career.

Hill was born in Dallas in 1949 and played cello in high school, which made for an easy transition to electric bass. He, his guitarist brother Rocky and future fellow ZZ Top Frank

Beard, a drummer, played in local bands such as the Warlocks, the Cellar Dwellers and American Blues, working the same Texas touring circuits as ace guitarist Billy Gibbons' band, the Moving Sidewalks.

The brothers parted company in 1968 over musical differences, and Hill and Beard moved to Houston, where they eventually united with Gibbons in ZZ Top. The act's original bassist introduced the guitarist to Beard; Hill would he got from guitarist join Gibbons and Beard for a gig in Beaumont, TX, on February 10, 1970. The lineup remained the same for more than five decades: They celebrated their 50th anniversary at a San Antonio concert in February 2020.

From an interview with "Bass Player Only" from 2016 Hill talks about ZZ Top's longevity. "I don't know that there is a secret. But you gotta hit it with the fun part. We enjoy what we do. They're other people that enjoy what they do for a living; turns out to be the same for us. That's as close as I can come to answering the question. There's a lot of different factors I guess, but the main thing is we just enjoy playing together."

Hall died at his home in Houston, Texas at the age of 72. The band's Billy Gibbons and Frank Beard issued a statement: "We are saddened by the news today that our Compadre, Dusty Hill, has passed away in his sleep at home in Houston, Texas. We, along with legions of ZZ Top fans around the world, will miss your steadfast presence, your good nature and enduring commitment to providing that monumental bottom to the 'Top.' We will forever be connected to that 'Blues Shuffle in C.' "You will be missed greatly, amigo."

The music world has reacted to the passing of Dusty Hill, with many paying tribute to the late ZZ Top bassist on social media.

Red Hot Chili Peppers Bassist Flea wrote: "Man am I sad to hear this. A true rocker, Dusty Hill, who laid it down deep and real. I will always listen to you, as will anyone who ever wanted to rock out, and we will all be moved."

"We are devastated to hear about Dusty's passing," John Fogerty tweeted. "We were so blessed to share the stage with the great Dusty and ZZ Top many times, and if that wasn't Rock and Roll heaven, I don't know what is. The show we did together just last week would be his last. So heartbreaking."

"Very sad to hear of the passing of bass player and co-lead singer Dusty Hill. Legendary musician and all around great dude that has gone too soon! He will be sorely missed. Deepest condolences to his family, friends and fans." – Travis Tritt

ZZ Top will continue on after Hill's passing, according to Rock radio host Eddie Trunk who shared a text message he got from guitarist Billy Gibbons. "Billy told me to share w/fans: As Dusty said upon his departure, 'Let the show go on!' and...with respect, we'll do well to get beyond this and honour his wishes."




Razzy Bailey
February 14, 1939 – August 4, 2021

Born in Five Points, Alabama, Rasie Michael Bailey was an American Country music artist known professionally as Razzy Bailey.

Bailey recorded his first single, 9,999,999 Tears, in the mid-1960s, but it didn't take off. When it later became a comeback hit for Dickey Lee, Bailey received a record deal with RCA Records and began charting early hits including 1978's What Time Do You Have to Be Back to Heaven and 1979's If Love Had a Face. In 1980, Bailey's most successful period began as he hit No. 1 on the Country music chart with songs including, Loving Up a Storm. He followed it with No. 1 hits I Keep Coming Back, Friends, Midnight Hauler and She Left Love All Over Me in 1980 and 1981. Known for

adding an R&B element to his Country music, Bailey the '80s.

Bailey on the first time he was paid to play music: "Back then people would have square dances or dances at an old country house. They'd take all the furniture out of one of the rooms... they'd have a big cookin' and have a little moonshine tucked away somewhere and everybody would just come and have a good time. Me and some of the other guys stood there in the corner and played in this big ol' country house room where everything had been cleared out and people danced. Then when we got through playin' they took up a little collection for us and I think we made something like 60 cents apiece. We were elated because that was back in the '50s ya know, so we had enough to go out and get a hamburger and a coke. We was big stuff back then." - from a 2008 interview with Bronson Herrmuth.

At the age of 82, Bailey passed away on August 4, 2021. "Razzy wanted all his fans around the world to know how much he loved each one of you," read a statement from Bailey's family. "He always said he had the greatest fans in the world. Razzy was a tremendous driving force in the Country music community of Nashville. He served as an elder in the Nashville Cowboy Church and was a long-time member of R.O.P.E. Razzy helped launch the careers of many upcoming songwriters who came to Nashville to launch their careers. So many entertainers looked to Razzy as their mentor and for his guidance in the music industry. Razzy was always /Folk songs will leave an impression on music for a long time the first to reach out and help a struggling newcomer to to come. Nashville."



Nanci Griffith July 6, 1953 – August 13, 2021

Born in Seguin, Texas in 1953, Nanci Griffith began performing and releasing Folk music while working as a nursery teacher in Austin in the 1970s. She moved to Nashville in 1985, where she landed her first major record deal. Griffith found Country success with her recording of Nancy Gold's From a Distance, years before Bette Midler's version became a major hit. Her style of music, which Griffith herself described as "folkabilly" was considered unique and blended musical genres.

The genre-straddling artist's best-known songs include continued releasing moderately popular singles throughout Love at the Five and Dime and the Outbound Plane, which others saw mainstream success with. She is considered influential and recorded duets with artists like Willie Nelson across her long career.

> She won a Grammy award in 1994 for her album "Other Voices, Other Rooms," which was made up of cover songs and musical collaborations. She previously survived two bouts of cancer in the 1990s and continued to tour and produce music - with her final album released in 2012.


> At age 68, Grammy-winning Folk and Country music singer-songwriter passed away August 13, 2021.

Tom T. Hall May 25, 1936 – August 20, 2021

Tom. T. Hall was a Country Music Hall of Fame singer and songwriter. He was nicknamed "The Storyteller" by Tex Ritter, another Country great, for his songwriting style. His hits included Harper Valley P.T.A. which became a major crossover smash for Jeanie C. Riley in 1968, That's How I Got To Memphis, Homecoming, and (Old Dogs, Children, and) Watermelon Wine, A Week in a Country Jail, I Love, Country Is, Me And Jesus, and many more. His songs have

been recorded by the likes of Johnny Cash, Alan Jackson, Waylon Jennings, George Jones, and Loretta Lynn. Hall was inducted into the Country Music Hall of Fame in 2008 and was a Grand Ole Opry member since 1971.

Born on May 25, 1936, in Olive Hill, Kentucky, Hall rose to the top of the Country music world as both a performer and songwriter during a career that spanned six decades. He began performing at a young age and played with the band, Kentucky Travelers, as a teenager. He joined the U. S. Army in 1957 and was stationed in Germany where he sometimes performed on the Armed Services Radio Network. When he returned home, he worked as a deejay in Virginia, where a publisher heard a song that he wrote, *D.J. for a Day*, which became his first top 10 hit with singer Jimmy C. Newman. Hall followed that up with his first number one hit on the Billboard charts, Johnnie Wright's version of *Hello Vietnam*, followed up with Hall's many classic hits.

Hall was also a writer, penning several books including, "The Storyteller's Nashville," "The Laughing Man of Woodmont Cove," and "The Acts of Life."

Country Music Hall of Fame legend Tom T. Hall died on Friday, August 20, 2021. He was 85 years old.

Many artists have expressed their condolences including Randy Owen of Alabama, "One of my heroes. An artist for all the ages!"

Ricky Skaggs stated, "I was saddened to hear of Tom T. Hall's passing. I loved him. He was a great Kentuckian with a heart of gold. He was a kind and gentle man. Lots of people come to Nashville to write songs, but Tom T. came to tell stories. These stories are everyone's story. They are America's story. Now he can truly say, 'me and Jesus have our own thing going."



Don Everly *February 1, 1937 – August 21, 2021*

Don Everly became one of the most influential musicians in early Rock and Roll as one half of the Everly Brothers.

Born Isaac Donald Everly on February 1, 1937, Everly rocketed to fame in the late '50s alongside his younger brother, Phil, as the Everly Brothers, which went on to become one of the most influential vocal duos of the era. Don carried the melodies of their songs while Phil sang the

distinctive higher harmonies that characterized their sound, and Don's rhythm guitar playing anchored the tracks.

Don and Phil had many timeless hits that included, *Bye Bye Love*, *Wake Up Little Susie*, *All I Have to Do Is Dream*, *Bird Dog* and *Cathy's Clown* and many more.

The duo's commercial prominence began to wane by the mid-'60s, though they issued several well-respected albums, including "Roots" in 1968, which served as a major influence on the Country-Rock movement that would later spawn the Byrds, the Flying Burrito Brothers, Linda Ronstadt and the Eagles. The Beatles also named the Everly Brothers as a big influence, and Simon & Garfunkel unabashedly admitted they had borrowed elements of their own vocal sound from the duo.

The Everly Brothers broke up in the early '70s. They each embarked on solo careers for the next decade. They reunited in 1983 for a concert at London's Royal Albert Hall, and they spent the next several decades engaging in a series of on-again, off-again reunions and one-off appearances that included singing on Paul Simon's "Graceland" album. They also toured with Simon & Garfunkel during the latter's Old Friends Tour in 2003, which saw the Folk-Rock duo finally sharing the stage with their boyhood heroes.

The Everly Brothers were inducted into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame in 1986, and the Country Music Hall of Fame inducted the duo in 2001.

"As a singer, a songwriter and a guitar innovator, Don Everly was one of the most talented and impactful artists in popular music history," Country Music Hall of Fame and Museum CEO Kyle Young says in a statement. "His influence reverberates through songs like So Sad (To Watch Good Love Go Bad), I Wonder if I Care as Much and Cathy's Clown, through open tunings and rhythmic sensibilities that helped give rise to Keith Richards and many others, and through the ethereal harmonies he conjured with his brother Phil."

Preceded in death by his brother, Phil, Don Everly passed away at his home in Nashville on August 21, 2021, at age 84 years old. "Don lived by what he felt in his heart," Everly's family tells the Times in a statement. "Don expressed his appreciation for the ability to live his dreams ... with his

soulmate and wife, Adela, and sharing the music that made him an Everly Brother."

The duo left an indelible impact on both the Country and Rock music community, indicated by heartfelt messages of remembrance.



I was able to show Don the photo of him, his brother Phil, and my brother Lefty and he said, "I remember taking the photo but never seen it. We are huge Lefty fans!" 
"The Everly Brothers were every bit as popular as Elvis. However, like most Rock acts, they were on a small record label. Cadence Records made a fortune, but they were in no way able to compete with RCA which is where Col. Parker put Elvis. I met the Everly Brothers in 1969 and asked them about Buddy Holly. Phil said Buddy took the plane so he could do his laundry. I think Buddy had other laundry to do as well. This started my thinking for *American Pie* which I wrote later. Additionally, Don was a great lead singer and unique rhythm guitar player. Almost all their hits featured his rhythm guitar." - Don McLean

"Don's voice along with the incredible sounds of The Everly Brothers was one of the main reasons I decided on a career in music. He and his music truly influenced every singer for generations. Gone but never forgotten. R.I.P." - TG Sheppard

SAM BUTLER

A Talented Man of Variety!

Family oriented, musically eclectic and Grammy nominated are just a few words that describe the life and career of Sam Butler, Jr.

ailing from St. Petersburg, Florida, Sam is the second of ten children, born to Bishop Samuel (Sr.) and Loretta Butler. His musical talents were discovered early in his childhood, when at the tender age of four, Sam got his start singing in his home church, Church of the Living God World Wide Revival Center Incorporated. From there, he, along with his family, became one of the opening acts for quite a few major names in R&B and Gospel music like The Staple Singers, The Dixie Hummingbirds, The Blind Boys of Alabama and The Blind Boys of Mississippi.

In life, things always have a way of coming full circle. One of the very groups Sam shared a stage with during his childhood, is who he later built a successful 25-year career with. Sam was the guitarist, arranger, producer and one of the lead singers for The Blind Boys of Alabama - a group founded in 1939 in Talladega, Alabama. Sam's vocal and instrumental skills helped to define the group's distinct sound. The group would go on to share the stage with the likes of Shirley Caesar, the Gospel Keynotes of Tyler, Texas and The Mighty Clouds of Joy.

Taking a short break from performing with The Blind Boys of Alabama, Sam went on tour with Mick Jagger and The Rolling Stones. On that tour, he graced the stage alongside Dorothy Norwood as her background singer and guitarist. Dorothy is best known as one of the original members of the world-renowned group, The Caravans. Once the tour ended, Sam would return to performing with The Blind Boys of Alabama.

Once Sam permanently departed from The Blind Boys of Alabama, he began his solo career with a 12-track debut album entitled, "Raise Your Hands!" which was recorded with Severn Records. This album featured Sam's rendition of an array of spirituals previously written by some of the greatest in Rock and Roll music such as Bruce Springsteen, Tom Waits, Johnny Cash and Eric Clapton. The album included features from some notable instrumentalists: Roosevelt Collier, Marco Giovino and Viktor Kraus, to name a few.

Although Sam is an accomplished Gospel artist, he has collaborated with some of the most legendary names across




multiple genres of music. Over the course of Sam's career, he has been blessed to collaborate with the likes of Laurie Anderson, Chris Brubeck, Gary Katz, Keith Richards, guitarist for The Rolling Stones; Donald Fagan of Steely Dan and Bobby Womack. He has been nominated for both a Grammy and two Dove Awards for his collaboration with Gospel artist Clarence Fountain of The Blind Boys of Alabama for the project "Stepping Up, Stepping Out", executive produced by Solomon Burke.

What makes the musical career of Sam Butler, Jr. even more interesting and unique is that he didn't simply stick with the traditional forms of singing and performing Gospel music. He diversified his music career with becoming an original cast member of the off-broadway play, "The Gospel at Colonus" - an African American musical adaptation of the Greek mythology story of Oedipus at Colonus, written by the ancient Greek tragedian, Sophocles. This musical was performed at the famous Apollo Theater in Harlem, New York and toured to several countries around the world. While performing as part of this cast, Sam worked alongside Academy Award winner, Morgan Freeman and Golden Globe, Tony and Emmy Award nominated actor, Charles Dutton.


Sam Butler, Jr. continues to use his musical talents and expertise to spread the Gospel around the world. In recent years, he created a Gospel group with his wife Valerie, son - Sam III and two daughters - Shamara and Samia, blending both Traditional and Contemporary Gospel. One of the group's biggest and notable performances include appearing at The Blues Festival in New Orleans. Louisiana. In lieu of creating a family group, Sam is continuing his solo career and embarking upon a few other endeavors.

Where some artists are starting to slow down once they've reached a certain age and level of achievement, God has opened even more doors for new and exciting opportunities in Sam's career. He's branching out and writing his first movie entitled "The Book of Clarence," about the life and death of his former group member, Clarence Fountain. While he is currently pastoring at the Church of the Living God in Minneapolis, Minnesota, he has also partnered with Scott Enterprises & Media who is marketing him to a Southern Gospel audience, breaking him into yet another musical genre. He has charted his first single release entitled *Child of God* on Cashbox's Top 100 and his music can be found on most digital and streaming platforms.




